So welcome back, let's let's kind of reintroduce our new audience since we have grown it let's reintroduce them to the idea of the pharaohs pump Foundation, how it is that you came into this realm of research, Steven, and what the Pharos pump foundation is all about.

Well, it's a nonprofit foundation founded here in the United States, a 501 c three organization dedicated to understanding how and why the Great Pyramid was built. And the focus of our research is that the Great Pyramid was infrastructure that actually helped the people who built it, instead of just being a big pile of rocks, that didn't really protect the pharaohs body or anything like that. Yeah, but that the Great Pyramid was a functioning machine. And it was built using water locks level by level. And that the purpose of that huge infrastructure, that expensive building was to provide prosperity for those who built it by being a water pump.

And it's a really interesting concept, the idea of it being a water pump. And well, we'll get into some of the physics behind that here in a minute. Because when when you start looking at the typical slice diagram down the middle of just the classic illustration of the interior of the Great Pyramid, it's really interesting to look at it and see it as a single cycle engine. And really, really wild. So what was it that first brought this idea to your mind, Steven, because, of course this is. This is not necessarily adopted thinking by typical archaeology, it's not necessarily adopted thinking by mainstream Egyptology

or it's not well, it's actually the, the genesis of the whole idea is from a guy, a researcher named Edward conkel. And he privately published a book called Pharaohs pop, and I read that book and was fascinated by it. And he talks about the Great Pyramid being assembled using water locks and barges that the Great Pyramid had a huge return on investment, and that it helped people in a tangible A way that the Great Pyramid turned the desert into a garden. And the Great Pyramid turned toil into leisure. And so we built on that book. It was originally published in 1962. And ultimately, to honor him started a nonprofit foundation with the title of his book, in the name of the foundation. So that's that's how I got started. And then went on and wrote several books and produced some documentaries, traveled to Egypt, and then went on from there.

So they say oh, big, heavy, big, heavy stone. 70 tons, which is the weight of a locomotive. Oh, yeah. Strong back workers just drove that up up a ramp. Well, Egyptologists have never moved to 70 ton payload one inch Yes. So

Yeah. Well, what's interesting about studying ancient structures is that there is a constant. And that is that constant is humans. It's difficult to say, oh, humans did this, you know, especially in agrarian society, they made precision stone cutting, large scale precision stone cutting, like the casing stones of the Great Pyramid. But in modern times, they're still humans, we have that. That same feature, that same constant, but now we can't do it. Yeah. And it's just very, I just don't know how they can how they can get away with that. You know, it's like saying, well, in the past, cows jumped over the moon. Okay, you know, that's part of our as part of what we believe is caused up over the moon. But now, we can't really demonstrate that but cows are the same. And that's that's where Egyptology is right now. Yeah, it's strange. And they talk about the Piltdown skull, you know, for a whole generation in colleges. Oh, yeah, they wrote their doctoral thesis on the Piltdown skull. But the experts, the best experts in the world couldn't see the file marks on it. And it took a whole generation for the Piltdown skull to be deemed a fraud, not because anyone changed their minds. It's because the people at first research to Piltdown skull, those anthropologists, those experts had to die off, never changing their mind. And the next generation of anthropologists said, Oh, the Piltdown skulls a hoax, but never changed their mind. So we're just waiting for Egyptologist to die off. And that's what's going on right now. I don't know anyone past the eighth grade. Who thinks that extremely precise stone cutting was accomplished using hand tools. It's just and then there's there's certainly other flaws in their research, you know, their sequence of pyramid construction, and a few a few other things, their interpretation of hieroglyphics and their steadfast refusal to even look at anything that's different than what they say. So it's a it's a it's a precarious position to become an Egyptologist these days, I think,

yeah. And I've got part of the video that you made the first video about the lock system and how it was possibly created. Let's let's start getting into some of the evidence that is around the Giza plane that points to this hypothesis.

Well, there's a certainly a profound link between water and the Great Pyramid and the plateau watery erosion and huge boats son barges that were in tuned if you want to use that word right next to the base of the Great Pyramid. We think those large boats were associated with the construction of the Great Pyramid. There's other boat pits on the Great Pyramid area on the Giza Plateau. The casing stones were cemented together water tight with a bonding agent, very strong. So Harada dis described the Great Pyramid as being like an island surrounded by water. There was an enclosure wall around the Great Pyramid that we think impounded water. Flanders Petri found sediment inside The Great Pyramid, and that's water related. So jeez, there's a whole host of types of evidence that indicate water and the Great Pyramid have a profound relationship.

Yeah, and there's even quite a bit of evidence to show flooding up around the base of the Sphinx. Yes, quite quite a bit of water. And I mean, like beyond the water erosion from occasional rainfall that you would get in the area to the, to the point that it's like, where did all this water erosion come from?

Right, there's water erosion. And also, they found a harbor right near the Great Pyramid. So you can word search on the internet rate pyramid, and harbor and find a whole bunch of information about that. So yeah, they people say, well, it's real dry there. Well, things change over the years. And, you know, over the aeons, and we think that there was certainly the original builders were geniuses, and were able to provide water at the construction site. Other researchers contend that same thing, even Christopher and Christopher Donna wrote the Giza Power Plant he says that water was associated with the Great Pyramid and even entered the descending passage into inside the Great Pyramid. So it's not just myself. It's other researchers as well.

Yeah, there's no hieroglyphics no writing other places like on temples and actual tombs in the, in the Valley of the Kings, everything is written on they wrote stuff on everything they wanted to tell you. But the Great Pyramid is a machine, just like the inside of your car engine in the cylinders and pistons. You might see a part number, but they don't have anything written down to tell you something because it's a machine. That's not what it does. It's a part of a greater whole. Right? Well, let's start getting into that real quick about a the, the internal construction what what it did, how it was a pump, and how that helped the people. Because I mean, you of course, get into that much more in the great prosperity, Great Pyramid prosperity machine. Great Pyramid water pump. But let let's start getting into that a little bit.

Well, we think that the Subterranean Chamber and associated cuttings into the solid bedrock, were a type of water pump and we think that they this design of the Subterranean Chamber with on one and the far end has some unusual nouns that some people say was unfinished. We think those serve a purpose of a water break if you will, and water comes in. From the descending passage on the other end of the chamber, and it causes a massive, powerful Whirlpool. And it uses the force of implosion described Viktor Schauberger, a Austrian naturalist from the 40s and 50s, who did a lot of research in water flow and that type of thing. But we think the force of implosion was used to pump water, up to through the Grotto and to the bottom and of the Grand Gallery. And that pump was also used to supply water for the water locks. So and then the rest of the chambers in the great pyramid structure were also a water pump. It was like two water pumps in sequence, and the Grand Gallery, the separated hydrogen and oxygen, and ignited those gases, which ultimately created a vacuum, which threw the water up the Grand Gallery. And then they were able to release that vacuum above that water. And that was like a 300 ton water piston moving down, pushing water into the Queen's Chamber, which the top half had air so it was half filled with air and water, which compress that air to a high pressure. And that water pressure ultimately moved water up to the king's chamber and then out the King's Chamber vents. That's a very abbreviated explanation. But my book, my second book and second documentary, describe that in excruciating detail

well, and what's great is the excruciating detail. Honestly, because like we've said in your last visit, it's like it was a water cylinder singles, single engine pump, single cycle engine, where like you said, All you had to do was ignite the, the hydrogen and oxygen that's being separated. And once again, the you can do that through numerous processes, folks, you do not need electrolysis for that. Mm hmm. You can do that with chemical processes. Yes, you can do that. You can do that with metal alloys and naturally occurring sulfuric acid. Yes. All all kinds of things.
