The two that I have here in my library are extraterrestrial contact, what to do when you have been abducted, as well as her new book, forbidden knowledge, a personal journey from alien abduction to spiritual transformation. Kathleen has been

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involved with MUFON for numerous years. She is a field investigator. She's a good friend of our friend and guests of talk. Welcome to the show. Kathleen, how are you today? Thank you. It's great to be with you. I'm doing terrific. Man. I am so excited to have you on the show. Like I told you in the pre interview. I have been into your work for years. I love your writing. And the topic of abduction. I think

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it's almost one of the dirty secrets of you followed up, sadly, oh, well, you know, you hear so many things about crop circles everything else. But when you when you get to the point of abduction,

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you lose a lot of people. And it's it's kind of sad because that is one of the things that it's that is a close encounter of the fourth kind is abduction, folks. So let's get into real quick Kathleen before we get into your realm of work, what you do for MUFON all of that how did you come into the world have you follow GE How did you get involved with this?

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Well, I was 13 years old and returning home from school for the day. When I walked in and found my mother on the telephone having a very unusual conversation with my Aunt Betty hill. It was September 20 1961. And she and my uncle had been on a short vacation to Niagara Falls to Montreal. And then during the night when they were returning home to their home on the sea coast of New Hampshire. They had a close encounter with a UFO they called a flying saucers in those days. And it had come so close to them. In fact, it had hovered silently, only a couple of 100 feet above their vehicle. My uncle who was a confirmed skeptic, got out of the car and insisted that he was going to identify it he had binoculars he when he stepped away from the car



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moved to an adjacent field, it was still hovering now about 100 feet overhead, and it was starting to descend in his direction.

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There were so many mysteries in that case. And I watched the unfolding of these events of my aunt and uncle's response to them. They made a project Bluebook report to the Air Force, they made another report to the national Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena. I knew many of the people who ended up investigating this case early on because we were a close family. In fact, only two days after this conversation that Betty had with my mother,

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my family, and I went to Betty's and Barney's home about 20 miles from my childhood home. And I heard the story myself from my aunt, I held the watches that had stopped operating, I saw the spots on the trunk of the vehicle that caused a compass to spin

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and

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indicating a magnetic field. In that area, those spots had not been there before this incident. And there they were shiny,

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all about the same size, about size of half dollars, if you remember what those look like.

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just old enough.



And, you know, so, so many mysteries. Betty's dress was torn in several places. There was a pink powdery substance that eventually grew on that dress. It's undergone scientific testing and several laboratories. Later on, because Barney had been hospitalized for a bleeding ulcer



related to this experience, a white hat and his conscious recall of observing these non human entities and being fearful that he was going to be captured.

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He who was hospitalized this was life threatening. He was referred to Dr. Benjamin Simon, a famous neuro psychiatrist who taught at Harvard who had owned his own private sanitarium, who,

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when he was younger, and two had been a colonel in the army during World War Two, and had set up the

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psychiatric hospital.

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on Long Island, New York, it was the Mason General Hospital, and he successfully treated veterans returning home from the war with what they called Shell Shock and conversion hysteria in those days. And, you know, this is exactly what Bonnie was suffering from.

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It was a different cause. But certainly that level of fear, yeah, and the subconscious memories of of having been taken, having been captured, taken to craft and examined by nonhumans, not knowing if he'd ever be released, even though they were reassuring, he and Betty that they only needed to do a few simple tests, and then they'd be on their way. So that's that was my introduction. It's really sparked my curiosity, but I went on to professional career after college, and worked until about 1988 to 1990 when I was stricken with a debilitating disease, and I had to leave my profession. I was incapacitated, unable to walk unassisted. And finally I started to become a little bit better, but I my condition waxed and waned. I was seeking intellectual stimulation. I had a dream of being a writer. I had an originally

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begun to study that when I was in college, I talked to my Aunt Betty about it and she said, Oh, Kathy, don't do something like that. You'll never make a living as a writer.

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Big become a social worker.

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There you go. Tons and tons of money in social work. Oh, yes, absolutely. The benefits

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So you get the health insurance and the paid vacations, that sort of thing. Well, I was left without a career because I wasn't well enough to work. And I thought, you know, something I could do for intellectual stimulation is investigate my aunt and uncle's case, I could do the research, the investigation, familiarize myself with all of the files, interview baddie drive to the along this route when I'm if I'm well enough for somebody else can drive us. And that's what I did over a period of many years because of that health condition that I had, that I no longer have that so I've been free of illness since 2012.

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Yes, so I, I'm extraordinarily grateful for the healing.

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I have written about that in forbidden knowledge. That's just one of many things that I wrote about. Well, that is one of many notes that I have sitting right here on my whiteboard in front of me is the healing that comes along and you actually quote that but before we get into that, there was a part right here in your chapter discovery that I wanted to get into that you mentioned about your uncle, Barney that I have mentioned so many times with our good friend and guests, Terry Lovelace. Yes. And that is the fear. The fear that comes along with these things that the literal stymieing Fear where you don't know what to do or how to react.

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Despite the fact of you know, carry at the time being not only a trained military person, but a trained EMT, somebody who was trained to react in emergency situation. Even he was stymied by his experience.



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And there is a part that you I'm going to quote it right here and incredible 78% reported that they are becoming increasingly increasingly psychic, and 50% can facilitate healing and others telepathic communication with ETs as pot is possible, and 88% of experiencers, sometimes on craft and sometimes in their own home. The troubling fear response by experience in our study, alerts me to a serious need in the UFO abduction, contact community.

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And I think that fear

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plays a big part in a lot of things, not only in wanting to come forward, tell your story to understand, like, like Michael Carter has said so many times on our show the fact of not, not knowing who else to share this experience with. And you know, especially back before the days of the internet before chat rooms, things like that, like, how did you even find that support?

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You know, yes, and it was nearly impossible to find support. Yeah. Back in those early days, you were aware of certain researchers such as Budd Hopkins, David Jacobs, and then later John Mack, Dr. James harder. But there were not that many people who were public, even investigating these phenomena. So it was extraordinarily difficult and people

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lived in terror. They held it inside because they couldn't risk speaking with someone because they would be laughed at they'd be asked what they had been smoking or drinking. Or oftentimes they'd be told that they were insane. And they needed to see a psychiatrist, or that they were possessed by the devil, and needed to get on to their knees and pray. There's a little bit of that still occurring today. But

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I've taken many steps toward assisting experiencers to Lord toward understanding. When I was asked by the Mutual UFO Network to head up their experience or research team. There were only three of us on the team. I didn't know exactly how I would proceed. But I began with Denise Stoner and a team of other specialists to by developing protocols for the investigation of an abduction. MUFON didn't have those protocols in place at that time. We did that first and then I started to talk with experiencers who were just getting in touch with me who wanted to have the opportunity to

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speak with someone without ridicule someone who would respect some guy who would be empathetic toward what they had to say. And would not pass judgment on them. Yeah, this team, I was very quickly

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ready to guit, because I had no time left in the day, there was so much demand. And so we ended up with 50 over a period of 10 years 50 Wow, people who are trained listeners who are kind, compassionate people. And also we had by the time I left this position, by the time I left this position, we had, I believe it was five to seven, PhD,

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psychotherapists,



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MD psychiatrists on that team, who worked as consultants to the team, and met with us, we all met once a month, we still do, I'm a consultant to the team now. So to an advisor, I've stepped down because I'm involved in other things, I don't have time for everything in my life. So.

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So that's a little background about what I've done. In addition to writing six books, the well and of course, you know, working with the likes of skin, Freedman for many years in the field, working with experiencers. And I think one of the things that they, of course, like you said, people people are afraid to come forward because of ridicule, things like that. Even even in Terry Lovelace his cases, the fact of he was he was a sitting lawyer. You know, imagine how many cases would have been asked for reevaluation, you know, absolute things like that. So, and when you talk about, especially people,

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like the fire in the sky incident, things like that, it's not necessarily the best thing in the world to come forward for your life. You know, it's just the opposite today. Yes. made public. Yeah. Like my poor poor Mike Weston, is, is in a in a sad, sad state, because of things.

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And people don't understand the fact that like, yeah, you will, you will lose jobs, all kinds of stuff. Whenever you come come out with this. There's a reason why Aaron Montgomery's book is called Dirty Little Secret, you know, because it's it.

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It's not easy even to come out to family with it. Absolutely. What was what was what has your experience been with this? Cathleen because of course, part of what you get into in forbidden knowledge is is once again, that healing concept. Let's get into that real quick.

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And like you said, there was there was the contingent that had healing abilities there. About 80% of experiencers are now experiencing psychic abilities, things like that.

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Yes, well, that is very interesting to me, because I've wondered, what has caused this. And thankfully, we've had the omega one, two and three studies, the fourth study is taking place as we speak. And the first two were done by two professors at the University of Connecticut, Kenneth ring, and Christopher Rosen.

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And they did a comparative study of near death, experiencers and experiencers of ET contact,

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determine if they had anything in common or if they were different. And what they found is that experiencers of contact had all of the characteristics that near death experiencers share. And in addition to that,

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they



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there's an indication that there is more trauma in their lives, because this experience when you don't understand it, can be incredibly traumatic. So absolutely. I mean, I have only experienced sleep paralysis episodes, things like that. I actively have anxiety attacks in my sleep. I don't know how that's possible when you're literally the most relaxed you can be.

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But you



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Those are terrifying enough even knowing what they are. So I can't even imagine the PTSD they have, which is what we now know as shell shock, things like that, you know what your uncle was diagnosed with?



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And, yeah, it's, it's not a pleasant experience for most, whereas most people, most books I've read, most people I have interviewed who have had the near death experience. It is a transformative and a stealing point in their life, where they realize that they have a chance to do something different. They haven't chance to change.

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It's not really something where they leave with a whole lot of like, whoa, what was that experience and questioning their existence? Or what's happening? You know, most of the time they leave with a mission.

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Not so with abduction.

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That's true. And, you know, it makes me wonder what brings about this near death experience kind of change in experiences of contact? I wonder if when they are taken to craft through solid surfaces, such as windows or walls or ceilings?

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Does this induce a near death type experience in them? Because they I've? Well, let me say first that I've spoken to two broke three brilliant physicists about this, but two of them

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at a more lengthy level. And but all of them said to me, Well, you remember 99.9% of the atom is empty space, right? And theoretically, everything has a vibrational frequency, nothing is completely solid. And if you can align frequency and phase then atoms can interpenetrate. So all you have to do is adjust that frequency. And that phase, and you can pass bodies through solid surfaces, because they're no longer solid. You know, what we think of is solid, we've already done it in a laboratory using neutrinos. Were just technologically not there. But someday we will be Yeah. So then you have to ask, Are these ETS as we call them, using this kind of technology? Or do they? Are they simply interdimensional? And do they have interdimensional portals that carry humans to their space? And maybe both is happening? Because I have many reports of both of those things occurring with experiencers of contact? So I find it incredibly interesting, because Oh, go ahead. No, no, go ahead, please. Because



experiencers have contact and experiences near death. experiencers look at the world differently, they view themselves differently after they develop, some of them become mediums. So I know many experiencers contact who are mediums, they,

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they have

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electromagnetic anomalies in their homes, they have light orbs that seem to have intelligence coming into their homes, that sort of thing. So it seems that they they move in a certain direction beyond the solid three dimensional humans that we think of living on this planet.

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Wow. And, you know,

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just to, to throw out a theory and a concept here, there. There's a scientist with a unit called the God helmet, who was actively experiencing with or experimenting with near death experience type experiences. And of course, this is all done through magnetic field, things like that magnetic resonance through the skull. And there have been numerous instances of people in MRIs having the same sort of experience, the bright light, things like that. It would be very interesting. Of course, the technology that any et civilization would be using would be

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highly magnetic in that in that RF field for levitation, things like that. So to know like you said, the scientist said, all you have to do is match that frequency and vibration.

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Much, much like you take any piece of metal

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will then stick it to a magnet and later on, you can pull it off. And it's a magnet.

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Yes, because the electrons are now aligned the same way no different than the experiencer. In this case, it seems like where where almost, they have they have shifted into

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that vibration. And enter now, like you said, able to see and experience that on a more regular basis.

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Yes, absolutely, it does change an individual

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at the deepest core of their existence. And they develop these wonderful capabilities of being telepathic of in the presence of extraterrestrial sometimes with one another.

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Developing the psychic or intuitive ability of becoming empaths, where they can sense or feel illness and another person's body as if it is their own two

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cents, the emotion as if they are experiencing it themselves. So that's another psychic sense that experiencers develop.

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There are many changes, and it is profound, and experienced or is, I know, need a place where they can go to feel comfortable. And many have gathered on social media groups for experiencers, where they can speak with others where they can gain support for themselves. My book, extraterrestrial contact, what to do when you've been abducted is a comprehensive guide for experiencers of contact,

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the different types of contact, what to do when you've had this contact, the stages that you go through from denial to finally acceptance, so the different characteristics we share. Yeah, and and you know, it's interesting, because so many of the phenomenology that somebody goes through the arc that somebody goes through after their experiences, almost sadly, like

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victims of abuse,

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you know, the, the attachment and even sometimes the,

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the utter wanting to deny the fact that it happened to them.

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Absolutely. Absolutely. Barney did that. You know, when when he arrived home?

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He said to Betty, don't ever tell anyone this Oh, wow. Oh, good can come of it. And while she called my mother, and told her.

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And then, when Betty and Barney went out to the spots on the trunk of the car with a compass,

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Barney said, We'd better forget about this as fast as we can. He

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What was his reaction to it? It's it's normal to attempt to forget about it to deny that it happened.



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Most people who have talked to me and I've talked to probably a couple of 1000, at this point, have said in the beginning, I know that this is going to sound crazy to you. And I have to reply, no, it's not going to I've I know, you know, I have a background in the mental health field. That's what I studied in college.

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And I have an incredible amount of knowledge about contact at this point. And

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none of it sounds crazy to me. I know the difference between mental illness and real experience. Well, and let's get into that real quick, because I think that that is hugely important to understand.

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These are not things that And granted, that's not to say that there are not people who do not experience similar things, who do have mental health issues. Absolutely.

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But there is a

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there is a great number of cases out there that are fully

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unexplainable as to how they happened, but fully real, in the case that they did happen.

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And let's get into that real quick.

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have? Well, yes, they are incredibly real. People who have had these contact experiences generally remember a little bit of it, they have conscious recall the psychologists who have come forward and said that it's all

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sleep paralysis are incorrect. One of the questions that we asked



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on the studies that MUFON did was do, do you have a history of waking up? Unable to move your body, you can move only your eyes. And you have shadowy figures overhead? Well, yes, about 93%? I believe it was I don't have the figures right in front of me said yes, well, those are the symptoms of sleep paralysis, and some people do have sleep paralysis, in sleep paralysis, it's, you know, just that you, your body's a little bit out of sync, you are not completely awake, yet, you're coming out of REM sleep and in REM sleep, you are paralyzed, able to move only your eyes, they generally are moving back and forth in REM sleep. So

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then we asked,

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Have you been wide awake? Have you had nonhumans come into your environment? Have you been able to move your body but you suddenly become paralyzed out among the general experience or group all overall, it was less than 50%. But among those in what we had identified as the UFO abduction syndrome

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group, which had all of the characteristics is determined by what was called the American Personality Inventory, chaired by Dr. Don C. Don Dari and graded, he was the psychology PhD psychology professor who helped to standardize this instrument. And what we discovered is

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that those people have a very high rate, more than 50% 60% or more of being wide awake, of having these non entities come into their environment of observing them, and also their family members.

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So we've been able to establish an intergenerational link among family members. Yeah. And that was exactly my next point. On my board, to me was the energy energy generational link, especially with hybridization, things like that. Now, with that intergenerational link in mind, are you yourself and experience or Kathleen?

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I am. And I thought that I would never state that I intended to take it to my grave. But certain

things have changed in my life. And I felt that it was necessary to come forward at this time, rather than to leave this information on for people to find after you passed on. Yeah, so that's what I am doing. Of course, there's that factor of ridicule. And I don't care about that ridicule. What I believe is the people who ridicule you have their own set of beliefs, that this is not real, or that this is all demonic, which it is not there. It's a scientific program going on here.
