And he they would all say that he didn't die as history said he did that Jesse moved to Texas changed his name, and lives to be an old man. He died in 1943 at the

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age of 97. And you know, so you grew up,

my late mother grew up hearing that story. I grew up hearing the story. And mom, when she when my sister and I got into college, she finally had enough time to start well to research and she wanted to know, the history books had one thing her family said another and she wanted to know which story was right. So she she started doing a genealogy going through family photographs, and my sister and I helped her. We, we got the photographs. And we all agree that our photographs look just like lesse and his in some of his family members. So but we didn't want to go on just our word. So my mom took the family photographs, along with it accepted, historically accepted photographs through the Texas Department of Public Safety, which is you know, the state police in Texas, and to their their headquarters in Austin. It was their forensic lab. And they they verified they, you know, they had their photographic Forensic analysts who verified the photos. They also use computers and all the weapons, the technology available to them. They use that they verified that our photos matched the historically accepted. And then they went, we went past that. My mom took it to the Austin Police Department, their photographic, photographic Forensic analysts verified the same thing. And the third one was a company called visie Onyx chain, they ended up called out by another company, but they were world leaders in facial recognition technology. And they also verified you know, so it's three different groups of verified our photos matched. And there were highly respected, highly qualified experts in their fields. So mom was excited. She took the story to Texas Monthly, they wrote an article about it, and that brought all kinds of stuff before Texas Monthly, actually, she told them, she called the James farming Museum in Missouri, and they didn't want to hear anything about it. We thought they'd be excited to know that Jesse didn't die, Black History stated. And that's the last thing they wanted to hear. So they I think they there was there seemed to be a feeling on their side. And that's just our impression, but I can't speak for them, but they seem to feel like it was feeling something away from them. And they they and at the time they were making about 7 million a year and tourist dollars in a small poor County in Missouri. And I can you know, we have a feeling money and a lot to do with that. But

you know, hey, we were having the conversation before the show, my friend but my family is for and there is a landmark at Fred's lounge in Mamu, Louisiana, and Bubba. Fred's is open other than Mardi Gras and the week before Mardi Gras, it is open One day a week on Saturday. That's it. They do this. Yep. butts to elbows. Wow, my friends mines to walk into this tiny little bar that's literally labeled with a plaque from the state of Louisiana as the home of Cajun music. This is where caging Wow started. So it's starting at 8am. It's all you hear is bikes, just lines of bikers coming in. And you can literally pass your order in your cache to the bar and you're drinking your change comes back to you. Because you can't get to the bar. It's so packed. So really cool. Well, and now, now that you know, you, you found out that you are related to Jesse James, this has been forensic ly shown from photographs of your family and photographs of Jesse. And you've come to this story. How did he fake his death?

Well, it wasn't on purpose. He tried to fake it. So a lot of people don't realize and in a couple of years before that he'd tried purposely tried to fake his death. And it didn't it didn't go through. He had one of the gang members, George Shepherd. What, you know, they've worked out a deal George George wrote in the town in Oklahoma and said that he'd shot Jessie in the back of the head, and he was there to collect his reward. Well, they wanted a bot. And that's where the plan fell apart on his first attempt, and that was in 1879. So they couldn't find the body and the plan just fell apart. And then there were news reports, we, you know, a week or two later, they're varying. Somewhere A week later, somewhere Several weeks later from around the country that Jesse had been spotted here or there, you know, things like that, and that just kind of the whole thing fell apart. So in 1882 They're in this one, the way he had a cousin named would hide it was his first cousin and would hide historically, ever in historical records and sources from there, the James family had, that he had for a strong resemblance to Jesse. And even he also was part of the gang he wouldn't he would. He wasn't a lot of the robbery. Well, people and that goes back to a lot of people, even the Pinkertons who were supposedly the best detective agency at the time in America who were after Jesse they didn't have an accurate description of it. So they were just going on word of mouth and description if you ever if you ever read through the old papers on descriptions of Jesse, they vary widely. I mean, some say he was an average height some say some describe him as a man of color man with a fine build,



you know, in all kinds of some said he had darker hair. Some said he had Sandy here, but anyway would hide for a strong reason was to Jessie. He was in he was involved in a race kind of like a love triangle between it was well, I'm starting to try I'm fighting not to go down some rabbit holes there. But anyway, he was involved in a love triangle with Bob and Charlie Ford sister, whose name was Martha Bolton. Martha had a cabin would hate would show up and you know a check up with her for a few days, and then go on his way. Well, Martha had a farmhand named Jim who she also was, you know, they they had I guess they they slept together shacked up or something but Jim and would ended up in a fight it turned into a gunfight would have shot him before man killed them. And in that fight, would height was one of Trump's two that say he was running up the stairs and either Bob or Charlie shot would heighten it hit him in the back of the head. So that was the end of Ward Heights is a allegedly buried him in a shallow grave it was during the winter when the ground was frozen. And shortly after that, and that's that's his death is he was the one whose body was passed off as Jesse shortly after that, I think they gave him time to thaw out and they turned to the body they use their the coroner's inquest that they had during, you know, shortly after the alleged killing of Jesse, the lady V. Mills, who was also a cousin of Jesse, who was allegedly his wife, who'd had children allegedly with Jesse didn't know the age of Jesse James or whether or not he had a finger missing or not. But she could, she could identify every piece of jewelry she'd ever had by memory, you know, down to the fine detail, but she didn't know any details about Jesse during the inquest. And I thought that was interesting, you know, just she didn't know how old he was or whether he had a finger missing or not. And people said, Well, that's because she was upset. Well, if she was that upset, she wouldn't remember at all, every detail of all her pieces of jewelry. Then you know when Jessie's mom was called in to identify the body. They brought her from from Kearney, Missouri, up to St. Joseph. And she walked in and said, Gentlemen, you're mistaken. That's not my son. And somebody. She was walked outside by one of the women at the house. And when she came back in she was, according to sources, very theatrical and dramatic, damning them all the hell for killing her son and, you know, just going on and on and on. But at the at the funeral, where it was buried at the James farm. In Kearney. A few days later, Jesse's aunt leaned over and there was a lot of people that are reporters, people from all over the country. His aunt leaned over and was heard that say, that's not the Jessie I knew. And Jessie's mom, Shuster and said, That's my rabbit's foot. I mean, there's a lot more to it. But there and we, this is the cool part. Another The second book that I co authored with my my sister Teresa. We, my sister had discovered a photo. And it definitely it shows Jesse at his own funerals then with his mother's Eropa. And that that just blew our late mother. I wish she could have seen it because she thought we'd always heard rumors that Jesse attended his own funeral. And I thought that that would be amazing. If there were a photo, we knew there were journalists there. Someone took a picture. And the photos available. It's in our second book, and you can find it online. It shows Jesse standing right next to his mom, looking at the guy in the casket, who was his cousin
