I have I have been in love with your research for years and years is Well as your work, the fact that you are one of the folks out there who is commercially using remote viewing, with your with your business car viewer.com Not only giving classes like a lot of people do, but using using it in different aspects in the corporate world, what brought you to the idea of using and using this technology in that way?

Well, when I first got out of service, we started working for police departments. And as we work for the police departments, we found that they had different needs, then, of course, the military does a lot of the same age, you know, missing soldiers missing people, missing evidence and things like that. But then some other people, once it became public knowledge, that this was be classified and out there, we started getting calls from doctors. One of the first things that we got was actually, from realtors. realtors will, so you know, show 10 houses and hope to make a sale. And they were wondering if there was some way they could find out what the customer who walked in, really actually wanted and would afford, and would try in order to not have to sell it, you know, show them so many houses. And so they started using this and, and got to where they were showing like three houses and making a sale. And so this was one of the first civilian applications we got, then, of course, there were people who this always tickled me, they would call and they'd say, Hey, if you will tell me the lottery numbers for this week's big lottery, I'll give you 1% of it.

That's right. You know, people just started coming in with new applications, new needs. And so we started using the controlled remote viewing for that. But in the process, we also realized that we needed to, like different advancements, and the remote viewing to get it away from strictly military applications and into the civilian realm. And over the years over the last 3020 some odd years, I guess. We have been continually databasing finding out what does work for the civilian arena, what doesn't work. We've started working for corporations, scientific corporations, research and development, medical applications. We're doing some right now. Space Research and Development. And just, you know, it's just blossomed over the years as more and more people find out that this is a really useful tool. Don't worry. We're even add a few times now. Training corporations to have their own controlled remote viewing. Yeah.

Okay. Generally, when this became public knowledge, almost every psychic out there realized that this was developed under scientific rigors and oversight from the government, and was proven database and so forth. And so it was scientific. And so psychics started saying they were remote viewers. And so we had crystal ball remote viewing, palm remote viewing, tea leaf remote viewing and all that. And that finally settled in to where remote viewing became the new word for psychic. Yeah. And the military however they, they research this, they found that the Russians, for years had been using psychic spies against the US when they were getting our secrets like crazy. They were looking for ground agents, you know, Russian agents, cyber attacks and all that and couldn't find it. And they found out because of the a defector from Russia, they found out that one of the ways they were getting our secrets was through psychic spies. So they decided, well, if they're gonna do it to us, we have to look at doing it back right back to them. And so they went out to Stanford Research Institute, and got some laser physicist who had already written papers on how the intentions of a researcher, just the mere thought and tensions of a researcher can affect the research. And so they hired two people. Pat Price, a retired policeman and Ingo Swann, a an artist who worked for the United Nations. And Ingo, started developing and methodology and goes genius. He started developing a methodology, which doesn't really concern itself with psychic functioning. Concern concerns itself with the fact that your subconscious mind has psychic ability, it has intuition. And so what he developed was a an interview and report process. Mainly just that interviewing your subconscious mind and recording what it tells you. And with practice, this was developed with practice databasing research, you know, and this was developed into a methodology where we had people in the unit who were sitting down and drawing the floor plans of the place where a hostage was being held, so that the rescuers could go in and rescue the hostage without getting killed. And, you know, finding out what was in document too often safe. So we're in foreign countries and things like this. What were the plans and intentions of some foreign leaders? With a high degree of accuracy by the way?

So we got it 10 minutes before the marine you do? Well, well,

invest in remote viewing. Now, you mentioned a while ago, the laser physicist SUID, who had written this paper, and it's a concept that we talk about regularly on the show, and that is the idea of an intelligent universe, a reactive universe, the fact of the atom has to know that somebody is trying to observe it, in order for the camera to be fast enough to catch the atom. It's not that the camera shutter is actively as fast as that atom or faster than the atom, it's that the atom knows it's being observed. So it pauses, and lets you take a picture. And that's really remarkable. And it really does blow a lot of straight, like laboratory science out of the water whenever you consider the fact that the literal intent, which is what you're trying to get rid of in science is the idea of like, an expected result. You know, that's right. But the fact that your expectation of result could totally taint your experiment, because you are unintentionally influencing the universe around you. That's a deep hard concept for science to get. So

And when they found out through their research and database and all that, that, yes, it could. That's when the government finally said, okay, then we better start doing it. And that's when they did the art of that was the end research area. The big secret thing, the biggest secret development at the time was them when they won Abrams tank. And, I mean, it was way above top secret. And so I think it was Joe mcmoneagle. They tasked him with it. And all they said was, this is you know, they gave him some numbers. This is project so and so. Tell us about it. He not only described it, he also drew it and drew it from the view of a person sitting in the seat on the tank. And they sent out the black cars they thought, you know, they were gonna do prosecute Joe, because they thought he was a spy. And, of course he was, you know, but anyway, that proved that it worked. And it got the government's attention. And so they said, Hey, If this works, Hey, lets you use it. So they develop the control remote viewing program. And, and we did a lot of good work in there. Oh, I was over in Augsburg, Germany. And this incident happened where I got flaming mad. And since I was around 12 years old, anytime I get flaming mad, things fall off shows. And, you know, you heard that poltergeists, kids, things fall off shows things break. It's always been that I get upset at work, the printers gonna go down, and so on. And so I got flaming mad. And when I did, the entire fuel station went down. General struggle behind the head of the Intelligence and Security Command, got wind of this. He came out to Augsburg and he wanted to start a remote influencing unit where we would destroy enemy computers, with the end goal of learning to control enemy computers to make their missiles go turn around and go right back at him or put false information into their computers and all that. And Congress had been caught in the 60s, doing mind control and they said, No, this sounds like mind control, we're not going to do that. So they wouldn't fund it. And so general, some of mine took me out to for me. I had no assignment at the time, because he had pulled me out of LP Berg. So it took me out before it made me put me into the remote viewing unit. And I am so glad he did I took to it like a duck to water. It's so wonderful. So most interesting job I think anybody could ever have in their life.

Let's start getting into the process of remote viewing because is it the fact that a anybody can remote viewed Do you do you have to be a predator natural psychic? And the answer is no, you know, when Ingo started developing this methodology, he took the fact that you know, martial artists, Ninja people, so forth. They, they don't depend on logical conscious mind thinking. Because if you do, you get into a fight and you think of what is coming next, you're gonna wind up on the floor. And and your intuition your subconscious mind knows what's coming. And so you develop the wax on wipe off wax on wipe off, you know, you

develop the physical moves for subconscious awareness. So angler said, Well, let's try doing the same. And so he would, he would sit you at a desk and he would say, Okay, I want you to say this pen and paper and make a reflection motion. When I say land, and most people would make a straight line or they make a mountain or something like that. And then space and water, then make a wavy line and so forth. And he would do this 1000s of times until it became a knee jerk reaction. And pretty soon what would happen was, you would make the line before he called the word And at that point, he knew that your subconscious was making a physical reaction. And once that happened, he would start saying, Okay, we have target number one for the day, which has a target. And your hand would make, like a straight line wavy line. Okay. And you say, Well, I have no idea what the target is, but I know that there's some land is water. And you'd open the envelope. And there would be a picture of the beach. You would like wavy line and something for manufactured. You open the envelope, there'd be a ship, sitting on the water, and so forth. And you train and train and practice and practice this. And pretty soon it got to where you could through this knee jerk reaction, you could describe what is out of sight. And then once you got you to where you could do that, he would say, Okay, now I want you to imagine you're at this water that you found. And I want you to taste it, what do you taste you always salty. Ah, okay, we found something about the water, and it's cold, and it smells fishy or something like that. And he would get your other senses involved. This is stage two, the training and ever get to where you could say, I still don't know what the target is. But I know there's water there that is really salty, and smelly, and, and cold and all that. And there's land there. That's hilly and, and you could describe the land that was there and all that. And then in the third stage of it, he would say, Okay, you got this land, that's hilly. Draw me a sketch of it. And you would start feeling your way along the page. Again, with a martial art aspect. You draw a line and oh, that didn't feel right, then you draw another. Yeah, this feels right. And pretty soon you wind up drawing pictures of the target. And then he went on to the higher stages. But those three main stages, those are the basis of controlled remote viewing is not where you sit there and close your eyes and and wait for your, you know, wait for the spirit to talk to you or anything else. The, the word, the term control remote viewing, most people think of Control remote viewers as remote viewers who are controlled. And that's not it at all. Controlled remote viewing means you're a psychic who has control over the remote viewing you're doing. And that's the whole thing. The English one method is not psychic in and of itself. It is something that is a methodology that gives you control over your psychic ability, by connecting you to your subconscious mind. Well, what brought me to form psi. When I got out of the military, I went to work for the Defense Intelligence Agency as a database expert on there. They have the largest wide area network in the world, even beyond brushes, and I still I'd be working on that as a manager. And as I did, there were people in the government who found out that I was I had been, I had become the trainer of the remote viewing unit. And so I was getting contacted by the people who had the security clearances. I got permission to start teaching them and the government the remote viewing, when it became declassified, all of a sudden, we had just 80 to 100 people a day phoning on the phone, wanting the training, because they found out that I was the trainer. And I had been driving into two hours into DC every morning, work in a 12 hour day drive in two hours in the evening. And it finally dawned on me, hey, I can train people and this and I don't have to do all that DC. garbage and fight with the politicians and, and everything else. And so I just took the leap, I quit the government job and started training, remote viewing and never looked back. Wow,

You observe and describe the person you're serving. And so I got this target, I started a session and all of a sudden, I realized, hey, this isn't a bad guy. This is a good guy. And I finally got a good guy, you know. And so I did this session, and by the end of the session, I felt like I was just glowing. And my summary for that session was whatever evil you thought you think this guy did. It didn't do it. This is one of the most perfect people I've ever met. And so the only way the I ended the session, the monitor, took the open the envelope, took the tasking page out and the director had handwritten on a piece of paper Jesus and would not say you know that I have met Jesus person, person and all that. But in the remote viewing in that aspect. Yeah. and the interaction there changed my life. It really did. Wow. Wow. That made a difference in their life.

Well, I am a field investigator for MUFON. And I'm also on the executive committee of the experience resource team. And as the field investigator, I deal with the 3d aspects of a sighting and with experienced resource team or the ER t, that is more than multi-dimensional. Those are cases where people have direct contact with a non human being. Whereas just the regular field investigative work, there was no direct contact usually. So if I get a field investigator case, it's often somebody saw something in the sky moving in an erratic way, or we're getting a lot of reports about orbs orbs more than ever orbs everywhere. And so as a field investigator, then I have to go in and I have to look up a lot of stuff. I have to look at what the weather was like. I have to look at what the Uh, what was going on with the stars and the planets, I look at any satellites that are going by, I checked out any airports that are nearby, are there any military bases that are nearby. And then I looked to see if anyone else reported anything like that in the same timeframe. So there's a lot of investigation that goes into these cases that were assigned. So that is for what I would call a typical case with someone see something in the sky. Now, when it comes to the experienced resource team, that's completely different, because now we're dealing with people who've made contact. And like you said, this can be an existential crisis for some people as it was for me. Yeah. And so not only are we trying to get the information, but we're also trying to help them mentally and spiritually as much as we can. So just by talking to them, letting them know that we're listening, and we're not a judgmental, and we're here to help them as much as possible usually suits the witness, we can also offer experience to groups for them to join, we have a list of vetted regression therapists and other therapists that we can offer to them. And so the work with the ER T, there's only about 50 of us around the world that do this. And I have to tell you, it's extremely rewarding. It's really, really a wonderful feeling to meet an experienter, who was very afraid, who tells me this is the first

time I've even talked about it, but I just had to get out of my chest, and I'm really afraid I can't go to sleep at night, I can't turn the lights off. And then after talking with them, and we don't talk with them just once or twice, I mean, I have witnesses that I've talked with for months, they just want to continue having interaction. And and by the way, we don't get paid for any of this. This is all volunteer work. And it's very rewarding to have someone come to me in a scared state and then eventually transform into a state where they're not as afraid they can turn the lights off, they don't have the TV on and they start to understand that this is not a situation of victimization. This is why I don't like to use the word abduction, abduction implies victimization. I do believe our higher selves are always at play our lower selves might not know what's going on but our higher selves are asking for this experience. So we can when we when we talk with an experienced so we try to help them understand what are you learning from this? Why do you think it's happening to you? What are you learning from this spiritually? And that information is profound, and it really does help the person adopt a different perspective about who they are about who we are and why we're here.

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it symbols are usually given to the experience or they're either shown to the experimenter. So telepathically, or they're shown on a screen, in a ship or in a room, or they are shown on their bedroom wall. And I've also received symbols telepathically. And the symbols that I have received are very similar to Sumerian writing. It's a series of lines and dots. Now, some people have had geometric symbols put on their body as I have. And it still continues to happen. on my Facebook page, I just recently posted a series of pictures about this geometric mark that keeps showing up on my size and and then they're burn marks.
