So certainly they move stones on barges to a lot of these temples that again, were close to the Nile, both Lux or and Carnac are very close to the Nile River so it's so they were geniuses and transporting heavy objects and they use the power of water's property of buoyancy to to move heavy stones. The Nile River is interesting because when you go downstream, your boat travels with the current but the prevailing wind is upstream if you will. And so if you want to go back upstream, you you put out your sails, so they could go both directions with ease on the Nile River. And we couldn't do that here in the United States until Oh, Robert Fulton made his paddle wheel boat steam powered. So they were way ahead of us by a longshot.

Well, they were definitely masters of the domain that is denial. They, they fished it, they worked it they transported goods through it they traded via. So to consider. And yes, they even dammed up parts of it things like that. So to to see once again the quarry here and its proximity to location to the water. Let let's start discussing how the pyramids were built. And what evidence you found while you were there to help support your theory about it dam using water and a water lock system to do so.

Well, I contend that the Great Pyramid was built with ease level by level with the casing stones for each level set in place first, and then the interior stones set in place. So they used water locks from the Nile River. And all the way up to the building site. The first stone set in place were the first layer of casing stones and those stones are cemented together with an extremely strong bonding agent. The few casing stones left in place today are still bonded together watertight, so they fill that enclosure that swell square enclosure with water. And so you had a square pond, about four feet high off of the base of the the bedrock. And they had water locks all the way up to that pond. So they could move stones on barges up into that pond and then they would move a stone from the barge and set it into the pond. And when that pond was full of stones, the first layer of the Great Pyramid was completed, didn't need strong back muscles or giants or a big ramp. And then they continue that process by adding the second layer of casing stones cemented together and another water lock to that layer and an additional water and use water locks. So that is described on our website, we have a video series that describes the whole process all the way up to the casing. So and my first book is dedicated to the assembly process used to build the Great Pyramid.

And it really is, as we've said numerous times just about every time we have you are very much a common sense. Concept whenever you think about it, especially the fact that they were already transporting all the goods there. Why Why, especially when the Nile floods annually

that's on a cyclical thing. Like you could take advantage of that all day long. There there are numerous things to support this concept of things being built via water lock. Aside from the from the casing stones, what what is there?

Oh, there's lots of evidence for certainly for water associated with a great pyramid. Sir Flanders Petrie found what he called Nile Earth inside the passages and chambers, which is understood to be sediment. And Heraclitus describe the Great Pyramid as being built like an island, surrounded by water. So there was a retaining wall that existed up until the 18th century around the Great Pyramid. And that was impounded water. So he probably saw that retaining wall with water in it. So it was a big island and a little lake if you will. And just a whole host of other things that indicate water was associated with the Great Pyramid. You know, water is the lifeblood of any civilization. And the idea that the Great Pyramid was built for a purpose that actually helped people has been very compelling that the Great Pyramid wasn't a tomb or anything that was ineffective in protecting the pharaohs mummy, but that the Great Pyramid was a machine built as infants structure to pump water. So that's probably the biggest purpose ever propose for the structure we call the Great Pyramid.
