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That is honestly one of my favorite things about this show is the fact that we we take the time to find out about people's journey, because if you don't understand the journey of how somebody came to the knowledge that they have, it can sometimes be hard to accept that knowledge.



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Without a doubt, without a doubt. You know, it's knowledge that I have basically discovered studying myself. It's not knowledge that you necessarily get in church or Sunday school or Bible study, but it certainly rocked my world.

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Well, let's let's start getting into that because I'm a former youth minister, you know, former Catholic seminarian taught Sunday school and Religious Studies for years and years. And there were things that I liked talking about like I love talking about the book of creation, love talking about Genesis and would absolutely expose kids to the fact that like pay attention that there are two stories of creation back to back here. Laying but take special note of that.

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There's there's definitely a dichotomy. And yeah, Genesis, there's two stories for everything, even how many animals went on, on the ark.

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Exactly, exactly. And that was a lot of the things that I liked exposing them to was not just not just the let's let's read from the textbook today, and these are the passages we're going to read, but really digging into it and opening their minds to the cup concept of conversation about it, and being willing to question why what's there is there. And that being said, you know, I wouldn't that I would talk about UFOs in the Bible or things like that. But there are definite cases in the Bible where pretty much you're talking about a form of technology that's there. Even even they explain it as a form of technology. I mean, teaching Sunday school covering for the preacher when he was gone, Representative lay leader, you know, on a lot of different committees, I've been on church building committees, committees, Pastor, search committees, I mean, building our business meeting moderator. I mean, the list goes on. But yes, I was heavily involved in Sunday school, the time singing in the choir, all the typical things. I was a mailman at the time, that was my regular job back then. And I had just made a delivery to a lady here in the county in which I reside, which is in between Roanoke and Lynchburg, Virginia, to give our listeners a idea where I'm at. And it was in 2016, specifically September, something told me to stop in my tracks and looked up, and I was standing out in front of the lady's yard. And I looked up, and above my head was what we now call a white tic tac craft. No windows, no, no sales, no wings, no sound, listening, the glistening, most glistening white, you can imagine the sun just reflected off of it, it was a beautiful day. It allowed me to see it for about three seconds. And then it wasn't there anymore. And, you know, I wonder whether it closed or whether it took off so fast, I couldn't see it. And the word spirit can be viewed at in circumstances in certain circumstances, as a craft. Example, a revelation for John sees a door open and heaven, He is called up into the spirit. And that's an every translation I've seen. It's even in the Koine Greek Yep, he's called up into the spirit. He's not called up in spirit. But he's called up into these spirit. And that spirit rides him around the heavens. And we get a detailed description later on, you know, of everything he sees. So that's, that's a good, a good starting place. And going

backwards, look, what happened to Elijah, not Elijah, but Elijah with croaked cloaked crafts. And what is that second Kings, I think, maybe chapter six. All these crafts, chariots of fire are around him. And he's got a servant with him. But the servant can't see them. But Elijah prays, and the servant has his eyes opened. And all of a sudden, he sees all the horses and chariots of fire up in the mountains and all around that he could not see before they were there. He just could not see them in my initial book, and make a point that we only see a very small percentage of the light spectrum, something less than 2%. So it's easily to hide, you know, it's easy, I guess, from a scientific standpoint, to hide something, just switch to the frequency, something we've already discussed. But these crafts are out there. I think they're out there. Now. They've always been out there. It's just as you say, being on the same vibration or same frequency perhaps, is what allows you to see them. And the inhabitants of that planet or star did not come to help the Lord. And that's something to consider also that any back then anything you saw up in the sky was a light or star if it was a light, I consider it a star. And stars don't leave their past, by the way, nor did they fight. Yeah, so so, you know, just looking at all that through the different lens. Now you realize that, you know, they're talking about crafts, without a doubt.



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Well, yeah, and I mean, even if even if you look at a map, I'm bringing it up right now. The firmament of the Earth, which is, which is pretty much the cosmology of, of what they had, at the time, there were the pillars and the underworld, which, for the for the people of Israel would have been shield. And the stars were permanent inside of that firmament, they they, like you said, did not move.
