So 366 additional reports since since the reporting was opened, when when the first congressional hearing happened, they had 144 cases that they were like, we aren't sure. Right



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now until our keep mine has 144 They had one that they had solved at that time. I do have information that's, that's new, I don't know if it's out there or not, between seven and 13 of the original 144 have been recategorize into a category that I can't say what the category is. But we're just said that the seven to 13 of those have been categories in such a way that they believe they know what they are. And the vast majority of those are balloons. And he looked out the window and there was a UFO flying right next to him keeping the same speed. And he said it was turning and when it turned is turned to a certain point. And he saw windows. Inside of that ship were two small beams. He didn't call them grades. We said there were two small beings. And then there were two bigger like, like taller beings behind them. He said the smaller beings were flying with craft. He said that he's like, you know, that's all well and good. He's like, I'm sure people are really interested in, in what the ship looked like he said, but what I want to share is something happens, what happens and he afterwards, he said, when when I landed the plane, he said, I went into the office and went to the bathroom. I shut the door. The bathroom stall is set on the toilet, he started crying. He said but during that moment, when I did the bathroom, he said I was leaving my body. In out he said I was suffering from by location. And he said at first he said I thought I was dying. Wow. Now what point do we ask the question of whether or not they were wanting to take his soul from his body? Were they trying to write it? Did he did he escape it? What I mean when somebody okay, what this makes me think of is it's like a Las Vegas shooting, there was a survivor with her mother and she was a mother, she was with her

daughter and her husband, she got shot in the head. And she said, I remember floating over my body. Now, this pilot is experiencing the same phenomenon. He didn't get shot, he didn't get shot, but it was really did fake I'm gonna die. Well,

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and once again, as as Kathleen Martin said, many, many abduction experiences are now being akin very, very much to OBE out of body experiences. 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That would be really fast, especially like, really? So hold on, I don't believe it. That's that's the good thing.



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But is it more a it? Cuz I don't think that it's like an active want of destruction of the soul. It's more, it's more a parasitic continuation of their own life cycle. Is, is what it seems like. So it's not like they are a possessing demon that wants to come in and corrupt your soul for the reason of defaming God. in the classic sense of demonized possession,



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correct, their their pathology is different. And it does fit the ancient understanding of the unclean spirit, right? Body density. And the hypothesis that I'm working off of currently. It stems from rituals, like the red right, the red, right, is, it's it's a liturgical ritual. But it's even deeper than that, and more physical than that, because what it consisted of was a magician or a sorcerer, who, when his body was decaying, and he was graying, and you're getting old, at a certain point, he would go, and incidentally, this is gonna sound like your production phenomenon. He will inseminate a woman with a fetus. And that Take That fetus as a new body to inhabit. And the ritual he performed was designed to take his consciousness from one body into a nother body, at that, at that point, the fetus is also taken, right because it's him. And he's almost in a sense, being reborn into this dimension. Now, the purpose of that as well was not just to self replicate. But it was also that because they believed the spirits believed that if they died, really died, without a body died, that there will be a certain time when they're going to be judged. And so they were kind of skipping that system, and kind of circumventing it by being reborn and reborn and reborn and reborn again. So that's an interesting hypothesis that's worth considering.
