You know, now you're getting now you're into tinfoil hat territory. You know, now you're talking about, you know, the minds too complex, you know, why would the government want to control your mind? Most people don't amount to anything, why would you want to control them? You know, and on and on, and on and on and on, you know, and, and the media just absolutely won't cover it. I mean, you know, you know, I'm into, you know, film production as well. And we've been trying to get a film done on targeting that's not a documentary and actual Docu drama, entertainment type film, that that tells the story of targeting. Man, it is, you can't even get a production house to meet with you. On that topic. I mean, the last movie that came out, really the kind of books were probably the enemy of the state. And there was one other that I think was called targeting that kind of came close. That was about a you know, a woman who volunteered to be chipped and controlled by Al for a while and it went bad. But I mean, as far as a legitimate Docu drama about targeting, nobody's interested in me. We've got the scripts, we've got the people willing to do it. Can't find any production, people willing to invest in it, because they know the government's going to shut it down. Some of the targeted individuals probably remember, Discovery Channel actually came to me I am wanting to do a series on targeting. And we got about two episodes, three episodes done. When the government said, You're not going to show that here. I mean, there's I think one or two episodes called United States of paranoia, you can find that they put on Discovery in Europe and Finland or somewhere UK.

Yeah. And yeah, there and gone much, much like, there were there was an ill fated series here in the States called going off grid. And it was a, it was a guy who was a security professional and literally, like, the whole premise of the show was, all right, so So it's time for you to disappear. Like there was one episode that was put out. And I mean, he goes through the fact of like, so so we're gonna start posting on social media, like three weeks before how we can't wait for the upcoming cruise to Alaska, it's been gotta be great, it's gonna be awesome. And the whole time, you're not going to Alaska, you're like, taking a train somewhere else, you

know, and you go leave your leave your phone at the docks, you know, and let it let us sit there and take off somewhere else without a phone light. It was truly like how to vanish yourself from society was the first episode and and it lasted exactly one episode. Because it was way too real man, wait way too real a way to like, you know, if you follow things on SVU, you have, you may be able to get away with a crime or two for a little while, you know, because there are some actual methods inside of there. And, and that, I think was the same issue with the series that you're talking about. There were way too many methods that are even just public knowledge that could be outed, to to real public knowledge, you know, beyond beyond the point of digging for a PDF, like, like we've done, you know, well,

in well, and then looking for when you're looking made known, the chances of any of the major media outlets, giving a fair shake to targeting, I can kind of tell you a little bit of history of where that's gone. If you remember, the New York Times actually did an article that they contacted me on, and we're like, No, we're gonna read it. And I talked to him before we interview with him. And I said, this needs a fair shake, because there's something going on in this in this country and going globally, with technology that's causing us Oh, no, no, no, we're gonna give it a fair shake. So, I think getting media involved in behind this topic is hugely important, hugely important, and if, if anything, to to outing the technology. Um, I am one of those if, if we can look at the elephant in bite sized chunks and which ones are the juiciest ones to start with? Let's start with the actuality of the technology. You know, because much, much like you were saying like Bigfoot Sasquatch, things like that, if you went to them with the story on that they they would at least gladly entertain the story as a story. You know, but when people find out and see the trail of evidence, oh, whoa, like, there is a massive amount of technology that does this. You know, and, and literally does put voices in people's heads to the extent of there was just the recent study done Dr. Where they reconstructed A Pink Floyd song from people's memories. Well, and you know, the rule of thumb they say is, if you're hearing it on the news, it already exists. And it's, it's about 100 years in the future better than what you're hearing. You know, and, you know, another story that I don't know if you caught that I was asked about on another another radio show was, again, New York Times article that Business Insider and several others, you know, kind of you know, rebroadcast but was a group of artillery soldiers in Iraq during when they were fighting ISIS. And at one end, it was a little bit high, it had this rock like a boulder. And it tapered down to a flat stone. And I'm like looking at it was it a rigid bedrock, it was straight, it was linear. And as I looked at it, I thought to myself, am I looking at a snake and I had never, ever thought of the stone walls looking like snakes. And I hadn't heard of that before. So I didn't have a frame of reference for it. Then I told a few friends and researchers and staff people and then I thought a couple other walls up there that we've been going by for decades and I looking at her look closer and go like Ha You know this one looks like perhaps another serpent it seems to have been had a body and tail. In what am I found was a great big S shaped serpent about 140 feet long with a kind of a triangular bolt ahead. And then it goes into big sweeping s and the spring of 2016. And Hardy kind of identified that one is Scott Walters, and I own Butler from England who's been on his show America on Earth. And other TV shows too. They're all over which Scott was kind of an entourage of probably about I'd say about 1520 people and we were touring the site, and I took them off the show specifically what I thought could be circuit walls. And they all looked at him and said, Wow, you might be onto something. It wasn't a to a meeting in Groton, Connecticut. And Connecticut is loaded with stone structures all over Connecticut. And that a conference down there. The New England antiquities Research Association spring meeting, I believe it was. And as guest speaker got up and he spoke about a town called North Stonington, Connecticut. And again, we knew Connecticut had structures all over the state, but it never knew North Stonington had even go instructor. But the gentleman's name is Mark star. He goes by Michael mSTAR. He wrote the book ceremonial stone work that year 2016. But before he spoke, I'm at one of the authors tables, I'm looking at all these books, and I pick up his book kind of interesting and look at the back cover, Twitter and 70 pictures, 1000 structures, 25 categories of structures, I said one must be talking about the whole northeast, you know, because they're all over the Northeast. And as look a little closer, I realized it's just a town in North Stonington. All of these structures are in a 35,000 acre town of North Stonington. Connecticut, one of the categories as I was flipping through it on like, they were circuit walls, and oh my oh my god any lists something like 400 of them in that one town. And they're straight or linear? They're curvilinear. Sometimes you have a 90 degree head bent or tail. And somewhere for like, the curved one I mentioned curvilinear, if you will. And the other type, we found that our site was the one you mentioned at the beginning kind of the big boulder where we did our interview.

And that one I think might have been my I mean, we've been walking by the watch House since we opened and Mr. Goodwin, the first researcher was there a 1936 visiting the site. And in 37, you purchased 20 acres of the site and began researching studying, photographing, clearing excavating. And he did a little bit of work on the watch house so he knew was there. But nobody ever saw the serpentine shape to it. If you look at it today, and that's the I think that's the shape when you're looking at you we get up instead early photograph because the trees are thinner there. Now, since we did a forestry project, but the wall goes from the right of the picture goes off to the left, it goes into the distance to the right. And if you could, I don't think you can do it. But if you could expand that, you know, it actually goes way off to the left again and it's in the far distance and insert another older like a round bolt or tail. Oh you can zoom in a little bit. Yeah, you can see it goes off to the left and it's kind of hard to see the very end of it because it's so far out there in the woods with the trees but it goes off you have 140 feet and it's a great big sweeping yes farmers walls started the 1700s 300 years of wall building but they're fairly linear with some exceptions.

They're made to mark property lines property lines, go curve like a river like that.

You Back and Forth would not make sense. Yeah, unless you're following a river but that's all bedrock there, you know, it's sitting on. Yeah, so farmers are built something like today and 40,000 miles of walls into England, they say that's the highest number of walls, miles of walls anywhere in the world in the New England area. And I didn't, I didn't realize that until more recently, you know, but farmers walls are pretty typical, like I say, marking boundaries, field clearing stock fences. Sometimes they serve all three purposes, usually fairly straight. And you can find exceptions to you know, of course, oh, but these walls do with these pigs sweeping things. Some actually loop around like the watch House 120 550 seat counterclockwise, and it comes back in front of its older head or face. And it does a hump. It did it does a 93 to bend to a pointy tail. And that pointy tail should is stuck out to all of us over the years. It is so obvious now you look at it all look at that. It's amazing. In its in front of its face in an order Boris, ancient Egyptian Greek in et Cie, that Native American artwork where a snake kind of biting its tail kind of in either the tails in its mouth, or it's next to his mouth that that is more rare. But I was, as you mentioned, the head of the snake is the boldo with the tail right in front of it could represent the horse. So that might indicate wisdom. It could be wholesomeness, it could be like infinity, you know, but also a sharpened can be healing or going to medical staff. There's two steaks on it. But it's in the Bible at St. Patty, it's Adam and Eve. It's all over the world, the Egyptians had it. But it could be it's protecting the 15 acres of the main site, you know, wraps right around? What could it be considered the sacred area of the that's a possibility? If we could talk to the builders, we know for sure, but that's what it looks like. Well, and

that that is one of the most fascinating things is the builders as as of yet unknown. It's not like there's an incredible amount of settlement there. For me, there there was at one point, a small encampment toward the front of the property where everybody parks, things like that. That was obviously in Campton by the people who built the place. But aside from that, it's not like it was occupied. It's not like you have it's not like you have found you know, piles of piles of church, let's say from people napping, Flint. You haven't found piles of animal bones from sacrifice or hunting, you know, things things like that.

Right household goods and they in in the archaeologists, they use the word Minoo. It's like a trash pit, like they were describing, you know, and that and that's not what we find there. It's it's fairly clean, psychologically, we've done 85 years of archaeological work on this site. But if he took all the shovel, test pits, excavations and put them all together, it would be maybe about an acre out of the 106 acres of land there, you know. So probably just under a percent of the hilltops actually been excavated, although they did a lot of work. And it is quite a bit of, you know, time to do all of that excavation juicy, fairly, pretty slow. And you might find a bidding or something like that, but we just don't find that than the other sites in the Northeast a number over 800 in North Stonington is considered a site and it can be just a chamber like next door town is Windham New Hampshire has a chamber we consider that a site to sure, but um, yeah, I don't think it's a habitat site. I think it's a place of worship, probably a ceremonial site that included the astronomical alignments because we have something like 57 alignments with the sun, moon and stars. And that brings in the circuit walls again to the circuit walls might be inspired, perhaps by the constellation Draco. In the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere, you have other constellations, obviously. And you know, I did visit the great Serpent Mound in Ohio. We were there in June, we traveled up from Georgia. We had seen the Edo amounts in Georgia this year. Then we went to Ohio and saw the site mount and then circuit model. We've got my son out there. My son's an engineer at Raytheon, but he's also a rally racecar driver, and they happen to have a race going on that we could chill a coffee. So he made his whole team. So I'm actually flew in from New Hampshire, whatever, into Ohio. And we met him at the Serpent Mound. And so it's a really kind of a neat thing to help my son with his team meet us right at the great Serpent Mound in Ohio. And that's amazing. And it's about 1300 50 feet long. It's built on I think, what's described as a stone foundation, if you will, but it is an earth than an earth and serpent. Always be in 20 550 feet is twice as long from what we understand our particular serpent Today, so it could be one of the biggest serpent effigies, you know, either stone earth or whatever it is stone in this case, maybe anywhere unless we find out next year. Somebody's got one that's, you know, 3000 feet long, which is very possible somewhere. My friend, we're we're Wheatley from England. You know, she's really big on dowsing. She's an archaeologist. Her dad did visit us back 40 years ago and she goes to Sedona she goes out to LA she's all she just came back from Egypt and Malta. She does these tours and she's trying to work her schedule into coming to us site and she's sending people to our site. Fact one of them came and then she met her over in Malta, you know, like the week after, but she's been sending me pictures of England and we've been here many times to England and Scotland, Wales. But she sent me pictures of circuit walls in England, and I didn't know they existed. I knew Scott Walters had went up in Scotland and he did every one of his episodes about the serpents, but they're in England. I'm like, wow. And that's that I circuit walls. We think today. You know, they're all over the northeast, as you mentioned, they're in Kentucky and Marchetti my friend. And you know, Mark, he sends me you know, Marchetti, he's great guy. He's in West Virginia, and he's been sending me stuff for years. You sent me a picture of one in Kentucky, or circuit wall. It is very remote, very difficult to find a woman wrote it up. She was an archaeologist, I believe in 1990. And it has a big, wide open mouth. I mean, the wall, you know, it has a certain body with its great big two walls that come out like a mouth kind of like the great ship of mine in Ohio, except that's Earth again. And I have one of those

five what we call the door. Well, I think you look at the way it starts inside the main site. It goes true south and we've always called it the true south. Well, there's a chain link fence that Mr. Goodwin put up 85 years ago, or 86 years ago around the main site that you saw that green fence is still in remarkable shape. They knew how to make things happen. There's a folder right there. And I thought after fighting that maybe we knew the wall was if it decided maybe it's a circuit wall was fit its prey. Or maybe it's pregnant in some of these walls, not only here but in Connecticut have a the body gets wider, like in the middle kind of ish. And then it goes back to its regular, you know, with some people suggest that's representing either you know what ate its prey or pregnant snake. Yeah, and we have that too. But it has this big wide mouth. And it reminds me that when it Kentucky, but we found it in Winnipeg, Canada, and Parks Canada is working on this trip, it was up there. We had a couple that visited the woman's sister moved to New Hampshire, so they're going to come back again and visit us guite often. But they were down late summer. And then when she was heading back, I think they drove back she was sending me pitches for a Sherpa walls. And I'm like, it's the same thing way up in Winnipeg. They're in Alabama. And they're in Mount Shasta, this town called weed. And I got 110 pictures of circuit walls. And again, they look like what we have out here in the east, you know, in the northeast, so it could be an American Stonewall serpent thing going on? Oh,

The I've got the messed up right now, of just a couple of the alignments, even when I was there, I showed you a lunar alignment that wasn't on here and took a picture of it for you. Where I were like the day before the moon would have arisen over over the stone. And exactly what I find interesting is specifically not just the rock wall, and not just the caves and their construction, but the difference between the the rocks that are used for pointing location. And the rocks that are used to catch the sun are different and made up differ I mean, I remember when I was there you and even even the altar stone things like that. When I was there, you allowed me to take a couple of the rocks and the reason I did was because they they're a different color than the rest of the rocks. And they specifically have like flecks inside of it of mica all kinds of things like I'm damn sure it's the Granite State

It splits the hill right in half. And I was talking to Maria about that. And in Wales to to England, there's about 700 Stone, ancient stone circles, and they're built on or with a mile and a half. She said of the fault lines. I noticed about the equal number in Scotland because I've been up there but I don't know if they're on fault lines up there. That's something I've been trying to find out. But I Machu Picchu is built on a fault line too. And they say that was all intentional. You know, and we've been to Delphi in Greece. And it was a fault because some of the guests came out they affected the people that were site. What do you call them? The Oracle, the actual

See, that's the East West chamber and to me that looks it runs through East and West in it runs about 30 feet ish. Not quite, but it's like the ones I've seen in France called Galia gallery, graves Norris run east and west, and the 20 to 60 feet length there is used as tos. And they're in Holland, they call them the Giants bed, the houden been, and they're also in North East, Northwest Ireland, we went all over Ireland, we didn't get to the northwest part, we saw so many megalithic sites. But I didn't get to see the gallery curious, I believe in Spain too. But that's a nice photograph looking south that's looking south from the astronomical platform kind of, well, maybe from the ramp area, but it's looking south you can see the table and beyond the table, which is about, you know, four and a half tonnes, it's about just under six by about nine feet in length, and it's just on four legs and just beyond that as a vertical slab. It's one of the monoliths it just beyond that is the entrance to the biggest chamber we call the Oracle chamber. It's hidden behind that stone actually. And in deep work, if you could look to the left, which you can in this picture, there's another one of these upright monoliths, so there are two panelists on either side of the table. I used to refer to them as Sentinel stones, kind of Guardians stones, and one of them's a little bit more narrower, if you will, and the other one's kind of wider. And I know we've been to England in the West Kennet Avenue not too far from Stonehenge and other ancient megalithic site called the West Kennet Avenue. They had the female and male represented by upright stones, and the wider ones were the female, I believe the more narrow ones with a male symbolic kind of symbolism, I think, you know, male female duality, that kind of thing. So it's a possibility that the table as you're looking at, you can see a stone on the far side of the table turn up on the bedrock. You can see like a slab down there just a little bit. Yeah, right there. Perfect. That stone we believe is a roof slab, another slab that blocks on top of the chamber. If you can scroll up on the picture now to the right, a little bit. Yeah, go right up here to the right, you see the variety. You can see a roof slab on the top right, yes, this stone wiggly fits right into that little notch right there. The heavier part of the stone would have been on the right on the ramp, kind of cantilever it with a very thin pot you can't see hidden by the table would actually fit into that little slot. Dr. David Stuart Smith, who spent 40 years with us he was a stonemason, he documented historical anthropology, theology. He spent the 70s from 72 to 77, working for what is today called English Heritage. He was in Scotland in England doing repairs on megalithic and medieval structures. He became a master stonemason over there. And he's from Connecticut. So when he came back home, around 78,

he became aware that these sites exist in the northeast, he was quite shocked. He was not only happily surprised, but he was beside himself, because I've been spending seven years over there. And he learned so much over there. And it was called the ancient monuments, whatever it was called. Now it's English Heritage, you know. And so, he he was he has an eye for that kind of thing he can tell with these kinds of stones belong. Not I'm sure not perfectly we'll never really know. But he was very, very good at that, you know, looking at the size, the size or shape. You also found out that these slabs, whether it's a table millennialist, roof slabs, any of these types of stones were all taken off the bedrock. They were actually struck and you were actually shaped, as you mentioned earlier, like making an arrowhead when you do the napping, but it was on a grand scale in our Dr. Gary who my state archaeologist 40 years ago, mainstream kind of conventional list, didn't know about stone ruins. You know, that was part of his learning, looking at our heads and points or maybe colonial stuff. These sites didn't exist in his world. But he actually opened his mind up to join us back around 1980. And he did three projects and he worked with Dr. David Stuart Smith on it. He was oolitic specialists you know how they made stone tools like Native Americans in the ancient past. And he said you We're big slabs here we're shaped using stone age technology in the same manner, as if somebody was making a arrowhead and a stone axe or stone hole or stone sphere. It's the same technology. It's not it's not metal age technology, it's Stone Age and it's napping or pressure flaking or percussion, flaking. You know, we have 34 slabs, like the table, not exactly in that shape about the size of that at all for the hilltop is 34. But we got now and they're all been raised off the bedrock, propped up with another stone, a small stone, in the edge of them, you can see where they were actually were all dimpled where they were striking it and doing percussion flaking the dress or shape it and they abandon this whole project in an ad to we do have one and that's when Dr. Kerry human got on that project. And then we kept finding more of them in just in the last couple years, you probably started 15 more. And it was like last year the before it suddenly dawned on me it was like duh, why didn't I I think he's people had a much grander plan for the site with all these massive slabs to be brought up. Some of them have 1000 feet for the main site. Maybe they had a much bigger plan for this place. And then it's like, well, why did they stop? You know what happened to these people? But no, February is the question you know,

I am now granted the table that we're looking at the quote unquote sacrificial table, as its as it's been dubbed. So many shows things like that. I am a big believer that your your site was used more than likely for initiation of some sort. Not just with the Archaeoastronomy alignments that it has, but but with the alignments of caves. And things like the man made caves, the caverns, the way that they connect in different chambers. Even even underneath by and the main reason I think this is because in Manila, ancient Greece, things like that. They were even in Rome, they were known to use chambers adjacent or underneath their altars to, to have the words of the God come out from underneath the altar before the sacrifice happened. Things like that.

think what we did study on 1999, I had a retired Harvard, us a Professor of the Graduate School of Architecture at Howard University really nice guy, he was so much into the design of our site. And also the other thing is water table. So he did a lot with the United States Geological service. So I went on with him a couple times on the road to talk to some of the people in the USGS in New Hampshire. This one covers from mine to about what we see a water like the rivers and everything back 10,000 years ago. They really don't have any precise information. They have more general stuff, but looks like our place was almost on a peninsula. For one thing, but the architecture of the site was his other big thing. And he actually, we went to Greece for our honeymoon. And he designed the, the, what was it over there we saw the building to he actually has his name on the building. And also, I think over an Iraqi, US school or university, he actually designed that. So he, he was pretty well known in the architectural world, you know, and he just passed away not too long ago, he lived in Massachusetts, but we used to go in the Oracle chamber and look up the chimney, and try to look at stars because they do pass overhead, obviously, the zenith stars, you know, the sun will never really go vertical, because we're, you know, we're 43 degree latitude. But the stars, and we were looking at that back, I would say, 2019 99, you know, I was still working at the airline. So I was kind of trying to balance all this stuff, too, at the same time, but we did go up there at night. And we also had to figure out that the Earth's tilt has changed a little bit in 4000 years to so we had to take that into account. That work was never complete. Yeah, it was never completed, said we should do more with that. Well, you know, when

and honestly, like I said, specifically on the days of the solstice and equinox alignments that you have, where the sun and the moon rise over these stones, to see precisely which constellations are directly above. Right, that I think that would be more of an initiation table where the Initiate lays down, you know, something like that. And the story is being told once again, through the stars overhead.

Yeah, even I think even more modern day initiations. I'm trying to think of some of the groups I'm not sure about the Masons, but there is the skull and bones, I think, at Yale, and they do things like that with their initiates, you know, and it's like a whole ceremony, and it's really emotional and everything, you know, you might be onto something with that, too. I mean, it's a really good talk, because we always, you know, that to say it was ceremonial, but we've also had people talk about maybe it was a place of initiation of training of learning, you know, and not just astronomy, as you mentioned, but other things, too. There is a geometry to the site. Yeah, and I don't think you have that map. I don't know if he ever sent it to you. But my dad did one and another researcher did one and they went from specific points all around the property, like a standing stone to another one to another one, you come up with equal lateral isosceles, Pythagorean triangles, it it can have a few of them, that will be coincidental. So but when you have repeating patterns, it seems to maybe not be a coincidence, you know, you have to be careful about that. I took that in college. Statistics can prop probability but it looks like there's repeating pattern of that all over the hilltop. So that'd be kind of mathematical. And then we have the astronomical, and then you have the architecture the site to that's a beautiful one of the I believe it's a winter solstice sunset. And that's coming up. She was in a month, you know, it's going to be happening. It will be having a celebration for that in a drumming circle that day. That was first cleared out in 1965. And it was because of the book by Gerald Hopkins. He was English. He was at Boston University and Harvard Smithsonian Center for Astro astrophysics in Cambridge, Mass. And he wrote the book Stonehedge decoded, and then he wrote a couple other books. And that book, triggered a TV show on CBS, the mystery of Stonehenge and I have seen that movie twice. I haven't seen it since the 70s. But it first aired in 65. And people like my dad, the other researchers, people from the New England antiquities Research Association, they saw that they said, You know, I wonder if the Standing Stones surrounding the main site, these monoliths have a meaning astronomically. So that's why they began clearing in 1965 in a gentleman that did actually became a nuclear engineer and He's a gentleman that installed the reactors on the Nimitz, you know, the Tick Tack UFO is where to put the reactors in 69 and 70. And he came up in his Buckeye triumph for the winter solstice of 1970. Pocket is mom and dad's house. We met him it was about a over footage now. He had built a wooden snowmobile as a kid, he built a paddle wheel boat when he was a kid is very, very, very amazing guy. I was just talking to him yesterday. He actually ended up in the nuclear industry all over the world in France, South Africa, up in Alaska, he ended up finishing up his career. When Fukushima went off. He was just about to head back to Charlotte, North Carolina for Westinghouse, I believe it was and they moved him to Tokyo to work on the mess over there. And he ended up being the last person on the five persons. So he had these bookends of the Nimitz and Fukushima. But he's still very interested in the site. He worked here for years from 63 when he was a kid up to became a manager in 68. And then he got in to working for the IANA on an image, you know, he took the first photograph I found out two years ago, he said Dennis I have two pitches from 1967 of the sun setting on that stone. I said I thought it was nice 70 Because that's when I went down with my dad, my neighbor and he had the snowmobile, he broke the trail we walked up we saw the first clear pitches were with us, but he took it as the cirrus clouds with a cirrus cloud, you could just see like, a bright spot setting on that stone. But he cleared that out using first and accidentally borrowed a neighbor who's a doctor he borrowed is changed. I went up there and they cleared seven about 800 feet of trees to actually see that study and 60 thought those are also something we discovered in the last since 2016. I started finding not only serpent walls, but I started finding what we call windows. Yeah, yeah. When I get that you I think I showed you a couple of those. You're up there. Yep.

Maria Wheatley again in in England sent me pictures after I did a couple podcasts because down the line afterwards. Domore England, she sends me pictures of her window. She goes it called Soho. So this was the spirits to go through. That's their interpretation today. Interesting. And that's that's about the press when I found and actually that when when you go to another pitcher that has a stone shutter that actually fits inside normally, we tell our visitors and all our staff, please don't touch anything. Don't move anything. But one of my assistant archaeologists, he he's a stonemason with a boulder for that. And he's been doing it for 30 something years. He said, Dennis, can I take the stone he has? Great, I used to work with David Stuart Smith, can I pick it up and put it inside that opening? Because I think you have a stone shutter here. So we said well, okay, we'll do that for research. So we removed the capillary, we stuck it inside it perfectly, then we put it back into the earth and went about eight inches into the earth standing up vertically, we have found other stone shutters, some of them were stacked up horizontally. In some of these stone windows, or this four of them next to each other, we have two examples of that. And then there's others just by themselves, but not Stonington. Connecticut, when I again, I open that book up in 2017, I looked at it like there's another category, it's Windows, they have the same thing like that down in North Stonington in the wall. So it's not unusual here. But what a surprise to find these things. You know, after decades of being here, never noticing them well.

And using those specifically Dennis. People may look at the image on screen right now and be like God, so wall in the middle of the woods. Those are not incredibly old trees. Right? There they are maybe 100 years old, something like that. So at one point, this was wide open field. So it was Yeah, to think of those as peep sights that you would you would cite a mountain point off in the distance, or something like that to find a cardinal direction, or to cite a star coming up over the horizon at certain times a year. That is one of the things that I've mentioned specifically about the the Bee Cave structures that are the beehive structures that are there the little buildings is are they aligned specifically to rising of constellations, things like that. It seems as though it would be a perfect spot for citing, citing stars, things like that, as a backyard astronomer, myself. I'm even building a small shade that I can pop up on my on my fence whenever I'm doing it to block out my neighbor's lights.

You're right on the money about that. And the hilltop is all bedrock with a very thin layer of soil. And David Stuart Smith mentioned that, you know, and we kind of aware of it, but he really put it into good words and really understandable because basically, it's windblown particles and vegetation decay. It takes about 125 years in in New Hampshire in New England for an inch of soil to accumulate from windblown solar particles just coming in there. So everything on that hilltop, including if you look at that structure, right here, it's sitting on bedrock, the stone walls, they cover the entire 110 acres, including the serpentine walls. When they built this site, I think they had very little soil up there and then very slowly the soil has accumulated and then the force and the vegetation came in, and then it became almost a jungle up there. So any astronomic alignments they could have seen many, many years later the trees the forest completely covered not only you couldn't see the horizon, as you mentioned, but you can even see the some of the structures they were buried in the woods like a jungle down in like Mexico. And, and that's why those windows haven't been found until the last few years. It was just, you're just covered with brush trees. And we had a forestry project we did two years during the winter are starting in 2019 to 2021, we finally finished it up and they did the 110 acres they send all the hilltop they did it to remove dead dying diseased, damaged trees. They also took out any any kind of know what am I trying to say? Take before the test shouldn't be there anyway, you don't I mean, it's

But I was just shown and you have to have a back sight and the foresight backside is the one closest to where you stand, the foresight is the one in the district you're looking at. And then you see the sun behind it moon or whatever. Well, we have that we have the back sight and foresight, otherwise, you don't have an alignment. And we also have the other type, which is called some people call type two, it's an illumination and that society that watch, the serpent hit the chamber, and that's when the light goes in and causes a shadow and light effects so that the light take to alignment. We have at least one of those. There's a Dear Colleague inside the Oracle chamber there's a window there. It's now the exit and I know you walk through there with me. We might use the app that's that's the one in the Watch house. Yeah, we could never see it because the trees going to our neighbor's property we're blocking it could never see it even with the leaves off the trees. So when we did the forestry thing I elation foresters name was Brian, I said, Brian, you have to open this as far as you can to the neighbor's property, because I want the sunlight to come into this chamber, because the Iraq was written about even enhanced holds his book in 1982, long before Columbus all about our site, because had been coming up since 1970, doing different experiences bringing up different psychics to our site. So 92 He wrote the book on Columbus's 500th year anniversary. And Bob Ibrahim quite actually wrote the foreword, and she's talking about that in the foreword of the book, that stone right did a quartzite stone. And she had her own interpretation of it, you know. And then one of our other staff member, she was a high school Spanish teacher, too. She wrote a book in 1996. It was first souvenir book we did, we just did my daughter. And I just did an update did our own just recently in the last couple years. But she talks about that in 1986. And so what we found out my friend Haley, who you interviewed throughout Las Vegas last week, she did, she did a PowerPoint presentation. She was here in 2020. And she had Sunseeker in her phone, she got into the back of the chamber, the trees had not been cleared by then. And she goes, if you're here and you're standing here in the equinox, sunrise, I think it's gonna get illuminated around nine ish in the morning, roughly, the next year, the trees had already been cleared out, and went back here and the equinox and basically what you see there, that picture was taken about eight o'clock, and the one you showed before that was at 830. So that shadow and light actually framed the top of the stone. And then it morphs into what looks like a head with an index finger pointing back at it. Our interpretation of that is good

The shadow looks pretty cool, too. It depends on what you're looking at either the shadow or the light part of it. But the fact that it frames the top of the shape of that stone is pretty cool. And then 30 minutes later at 8:30am in the morning, it actually turned into it looks like a hand with an index finger pointing back at ya in our interpretation today I've been to New Grange in Ireland is that this might represent that chamber might represent a womb and what it is is a son, the race, the fertilization, the egg, and this illumination actually is you know, it's about fertility and it's in the spring equinox it but we found out this year, three years later, I'm standing there at 730 because we have a couple other alignments earlier in the morning on the equinox, a big eight foot slab that fell down the sunrises over that stone was standing and then it's one year the Oracle chamber and that's just about 20 minutes later or so. And then we go

down there and watch the three Word Equinox events solar event if you will. And I'm talking to a lady with my back to the chamber, kind of like when you and I were interviewing there, yeah, but I turned it, but I was sitting at that time, but I was standing next to this. And I just have to turn around while we were talking and I looked into the chamber at 730. I'd never done that before. And I don't know if you have that picture. But the bottom of the stone has a perfect shadow, like framing it so frames it at the bottom at 730 30 minutes later, it goes to the top of that what could be an egg, perhaps it frames it perfectly. And then at 831 hour after the beginning of this illumination looks like a hand again with the index finger pointing back maybe at this fertilized egg. And that may be you know, crazy, it might be incorrect. But we've been through quite a few sites around the world. And even at Chaco Canyon on the equinox, there's an illumination, it's not this the point the you know, they have the dagger for the summer solstice, the two daggers for the winter solstice at Chaco Canyon in New Mexico, which had been two, we haven't been up on the Butte to see that it's restricted. But on the equinox, the light hits a serpent that's it, it splits the serpent with the shadow light right down the middle of the equinox. Remember, we're talking about the head of a serpent, the womb next to it, and then this illumination, so that chamber has a lot of things going and that boulder by the way, is a February 1 Cross quarter day, the ancient Celts called the Invoke candle mission. Groundhogs Day today is around that time, it's a mid season, the first hump in that body behind it is November 1, it's called solid by the ancient Celts. It's the All Saints Day today, the day after Halloween. And that hump actually is where the sun will rise on that. So there's a lot of stuff going on with our watch House, including two bones that were looked at it to Smithsonian in 1968 and identified as bison bison by two physical anthropologists in 1868. Now it takes a bison bone doing in that chamber I have now

Exactly. You know, there is a site that is in Connecticut, another one. I mean, I mentioned there's many of them, but the Gungi website, which is the the Navy base and Grodd. And the state now has taken over part of that in a University of Connecticut, Stockton, McBride and he actually came up with visitors last fall, I think he was pretty impressed by our site, he was impressed by gundula. But again, it's out of his realm, you know, it's not pottery, it's not a point. It's a great big, complex stone structures. But he was written about in 1654, we believe they were referring to guns you want a guy named John Pynchon wrote to go the governor winter at the second governor, John Winthrop, and he wrote him in 1654, asking what the stone structures were. So if these were all built by our colonial settlers, why somebody in 1654 said, you know, what is this you know, back then, you know, but we haven't use an optically stimulated luminescence. And they've been doing it from here to Virginia and 22 sites, and the

results are coming out pre colonial, a pre Columbian dates, and they actually can date during winter saw the light of day lash. So if you build a chamber and the dirt on the roof, or next to it is undisturbed, you get the core, they send it out two years later, you get the results back, you know that the structure was here and the jury came in after you can kind of relatively data, you know, the structure say, okay, the direct data to this era. So we know the structure is at least this fold. And that's what they did at our site. One of the one of the four places, they took the dirt samples from natural to stone and to direct one of the dirt sediment samples came from near the end of the tail of that serpent by the watch House. And the data that was the dirt was there in 1400 80 hadn't been so 600 years ago. So the wall wasn't built by the settlers 200 or 300 years ago, this thing was already sitting there. 1400 That's before Columbus, and
