I encountered an entity in my youth, that was malevolent in nature, it was profoundly deceptive. And I realized that whatever this was, pretty much encompass a lot of the paranormal field itself. I mean, I was waking up in the middle of the night hearing, full, like a full conversation going on, I couldn't hear exactly what they were saying. But I heard two entities conversing with each other, really weird stuff. But more than anything, I started to realize that a lot of the ways this being was manifesting to me, was predicated on what I would have a fear of. And along with that, it wasn't just the cognitive interface, the phenomenon employed, but it was the projection of terror that it was filling the room with. And so I came to a conclusion one night, you know, I don't really believe this fear is coming from me it was to repair paranormal was to supernatural, whatever this entity was, was using me, almost as a source, feeding off of the terror it was projecting upon. And so that was instrumental in my development as a researcher, I wanted to understand first of all, am I alone in this? Am I going crazy? Or is this

something that is global, or experiencers present within every country? Or is it just a little boy in Dayton, Ohio? And sure enough, it was, like I said, I was instrumental in my evolution as a researcher. But moving right along to answer your question. Specifically, once I got into G monological literature, I realized that there was a common semantic element, regardless of culture, regardless of what incarnation this intelligence has given us. It's prevalent, it's what's called pattern confirming evidence. And that's when I realized okay, there are some behavioral patterns here that I can no longer afford to ignore. Which I think is did the detriment of everybody and I'm not one who is Uber religious, so to speak, you know, but it's one of those that if you're out there and you are teaching a paradigm you need to be teaching the full paradigm I mean, even whenever I even whenever I went to my spiritual director at one point, with my experience of a shadow person grabbing me and they're like, Well, you know, we don't we don't really have a teaching on on anything like that. I'm collecting evidence now that is suggesting that what that certainly some of this phenomenon that is appearing as demonic is an intelligence that's masquerading as such. I can't go into it all. It appears we're dealing with a self replication of species that will use what are called Screen sequences or virtual reality scenarios, to bypass our instinctual awarenesses, something that will use a cognitive interface that is created out of archetypes we believe in, or that we've heard about authority figures, and then it will wear that mask in order to get us to a place of consent. And then at that point, and oftentimes, it removes the mask entirely. And then we realize, okay, that's not at all, but it's been occurring to be number one. The very first case studies included beings that were inducing people into dream like states. And in this is going to kind of freak people out. But sometimes, the actual induction into a dream was designed for that entity to enter the dream itself. Matter of fact, I'm going to give you a case study of mind, my own life, my own experience. Years and years ago, I was engaged and I came home from work and a Friday night, took a shower with the bed. And I'm immediately getting this deep sleep. And in the nightmare because it was a nightmare. There is a featureless shadow woman, long, long hair, couldn't see anything on her face is like a shadow. And she's straddling the dream itself and pushing her off and trying to get her off of me. And I'm hitting, I'm reaching out like this, and I actually wake myself up from the dream. And when I do upon my like, when my eyes adjusted to the darkness, to my utter astonishment, the intensity was still present to the room still on top of me. How could it be in two places at once in two different realities in two different streams of consciousness? Makes no sense at all. And so I fear ladies, gentlemen, that whatever we're doing was a stranger. than we imagined. I'm gonna pull a Terence McKenna quote, and stranger than we can imagine. Yeah.
