And it's interesting, because that's one of those stories that you hear in history class, things like that, that are that are very supposedly cut and dry. Like, like the Kennedy assassination, there was Kennedy on television going down the road, and all of a sudden, a single guy shoots him. While you think it's a single guy, we know Kennedy died. But there's a lot of curious information when you really start digging into Jesse James, and the death of Jesse James. And did Jesse James live beyond the years that we believe? Did Jesse James move to Texas, fake his own death, move here and carry on his life? And hide Templar treasures? Daniel Duke, welcome back to the show. How are you my friend?

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I love our conversations, both on and off air. Like we we met to do this pre record and have been talking for about 40 minutes before we ever even hit record. It just, it's great. And it's fun. And the adventure that you have had in your life, the pads that this story has led you down is is absolutely awesome. And amazing. And it's one of those that's quite literally, in some moments, the stuff of spy novels, man, um, to to the fact of when you and your mother were going to the State Archives, you had people following you. While you were researching this information. You have had active threats to the point that the FBI is having to get involved because of your research into the death of Jesse James, you have you have AD active like, pretty much cease and desist from the town that claims the death of Jesse James.

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That's true. It's been a wild ride, to say the least. Actually, that's an understatement.

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Well, let's start getting into it real quick. How did you first come to find out that you were you were blood relative of Jesse James and related to Jesse James to begin with? Well,

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that story was handed down by the family through the family. My mom grew up hearing it, you know, and her her dad grew up hearing the same thing. It was you know, every time there's a family holiday or get together that ended up being one of the big parts of the conversation. And mom decided, you know, everybody's like, yeah, he was Jesse James. He faked his death and died in old age and Blevins, Texas, and that was the family story and you kind of grew up just thinking of it for just taking it for granted. Why would they make that up? And then Mom Um, she decided in the 90s Well, she decided probably early 90s to start researching that she wanted to find out which was true, traditional, the traditional story, you know, historically, or traditionally accepted history on Jesse James, or was our family story the troops. And so she started researching a lot of research, which led to the, you know, things like going to the State Archives being followed in warned things like that. But she proved with photographs, she found all the evidence, ended up finding more evidence than then the James Farmer Museum in Missouri had, you know, they were up until that time, they, the the end all be all of Jesse James history. And and when mom came out with it, and our story hit Texas Monthly magazine, I think in 98. And then she kept researching further, she never stopped until she passed away in 2015. But she proved with photographs. And not just a photograph, you know, it wasn't just like, look, this photo looks like that guy. We've seen some hoaxers try to morph a photo of their relative into Jesse James. And claim that was it. I thought that you can do that for you can get free photo Soto programs and do stuff like that, that proves nothing. We went to the Texas Department of Public Safety, Austin Police Department forensics, what was it the photographic forensic analysis lab, and visie onyx, who was later bought out by another company, they were world leaders in facial recognition technology, they verify those three different organizations verified that our family photos of Jesse and his other family members matched. And so you know, we had that, but DNA seems to be the the end all be all these days anyway until science comes up with another way. So there was a lady and I'm I'm getting way ahead of myself.

There's a lot more between everything I'm saying but there was a lady who has a direct descendant of the James family, you know, who carried the same mitochondrial DNA. And mitochondrial DNA is passed down from through the females. Like if your mom, you have your mom's DNA, but because you have her mitochondrial DNA, but because you're a male, you can't pass that to your children. They'll get the other DNA but not mitochondrial. So yeah, that was what the big test was back in 1995. When they hired a fast the James farming Museum, hired Professor James the stars, he wasn't a doctor. He was a professor of law. I don't know why they hired him to do a forensic investigation. But he he dug up the grave in Kearney, Missouri, found multiple bodies, and he was trying to get some kind of good sample of DNA, mitochondrial DNA from the grave couldn't get it. He presented it as that in his final. His final report, which took four took him forever to publish. But he he presented it as coming from the grave but it didn't come from the grave. It came from a Tupperware bowl that was kept at the museum for years. Oh, and the contents of which were dug up by a curator of the museum in 1978. He found hog bones, dog bones, and a human tooth and a couple of other bones. And he kept them in a tupperware bowl and would hand them out to friends. And they pass it around. So it's already contaminated from other people just handling it. They ended up putting that in the they gave or the control of that was in the hands of the farm meeting the James farming museum. And their attorney Steven Caruso was the one who had access to it. He told my mother and I face to face he was against that exclamation in 95. They ran it like a circus and in his words, it was a tawdry sideshow. They they, you know, they mishandled everything. And he said he was orderly. Long story short, James Lee stars the professor of law who was doing a forensic dig. He got a court order to get Caruso who used to be the Clay County attorney, their attorney. They forced him they ordered him to hand over the tooth and and Jesse's hair. He told us in fate in person. He pulled the hair from John Hartman's head, who was the Clay County Parks director, and he submitted that as the hair they wanted. He said an eye he didn't give us details. But he said I guarantee you the tooth had similar origins. And he kind of laughed, and he said I didn't like them. I didn't like the way they were doing it. And I didn't I wasn't gonna bow to their orders. So he didn't They tested a tooth that didn't belong to any body. It wasn't even the tooth from the Tupperware bowl. And then they tested the hair from John Hartman and on their documentary claimed that that was definitely Jessie's hair because it was known that Jesse dyed his hair before robberies, and this had traces of diet, which David Caruso got a kick out of, because his buddy John Hartman, whose hair it was, he was given him a hard time about dyeing his hair. But, so, they claimed that there was no living descendant who had that mitochondrial DNA. Yet every historian knows there was a woman named Sue Laura Hale, who was a direct female descended from Xarelto Xarelto. James, that was Jesse and Frank's mother, Sue Laura, Hal was living in California, she was in her early 90s. And mom contacted her and got permission, the woman sued, Miss Hale went to her doctor, they took a sample of blood, submitted it through strict chain of custody to our DNA guy in San Antonio. And he tested that against mom and proved there is a definite relationship. But he went further and told us for something like this to stand up in court, you're gonna have to exhume everybody from my mother, you know, like her dad, our grandmother, and then finally, Jesse's grave. So you've got all your eyes dotted and your T's crossed. But as it stands right now, we've got DNA proof that there's a relationship. On top of all the census death records. His diary, mentioning basic with his own signature that says Jesse James guard, says, J. James and J. W. J, in different places in his diary, and known known gang members, date robberies they did with we've got more proof than the historians have ever dreamed of having. And



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and, you know, this is really one of the and even the photographic evidence, once again, that

has been examined and examined and examined to show the fact that, yeah, that is literally Jesse James standing at the funeral of himself,

There's a lot of other hoaxers J Frank Dalton was the biggest hoax or yet but at the same time, they have evidence and J. Frank Dalton, while he wasn't Jesse James had a lot of he had a lot of info on the treasures that a normal person wouldn't have known as



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as in what let's let's get into that for a minute because there was a point where you actively found a treasure map.



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Yeah, where one passed down through the family. Yeah, yeah. Um, but that one that was hard to read. It didn't give any topographical location. We knew it was in Blevins, Texas but we didn't know where it you know, a typical map like you know, growing up watching pirate movies, you think X marks the spot, and you go this far from the old oak tree. It had it was nothing like that it was just a geometrical symbol with a weird drawing of what looked like a man's face. And it was a lot of codes and diagrams and just dashed lines and straight lines, solid lines. With code, some of the code was easy to break. Some of it is it seems impossible, but we didn't know. You know, I thought, okay, it's a treasure map. But where do you start? We had no clue. Nobody had a clue. And that's when I got into read, you know, researching everything. The guy. There was two men who broke that for me, who helped me crack that code. One was the former Attorney General for the state of Texas Wagner car, who was also mixed up in the JFK stuff. He was on the Warren Warren Commission. That's a weird story in itself. Anyway, he sent his driver out to show my mother and I were three, three large catches were recovered. And then there was a man named George roaming, who was a World War Two vet. It was 32nd degree Freemason. He contacted us when he was a kid, Jesse was an old man still alive. And Jesse swore he swore George to an oath when he was like 10 to 1212 years old. And that's when George went out with Jesse helped him move 680. But actually a 700 bars of gold, they buried

680 bars, each weighing approximately 15 pounds. So George drew a map, it was about a year and a half before he died. He drew a map for my mother and I told us exactly where it was, and it's on Fort Hood military reservation. So we weren't going to get that morning, you know, that had absolutely I wouldn't even I wouldn't never attempt not waiting in prison for life or dead. So, but the good thing about that, I took Wagner cars, three locations that he showed us in George's location as firsthand account. And it fit perfectly on a template. And you can Google that. Yeah. And you'll find the template. It's real. It's a really crude looking template. I've seen the template off and on just doing the research and actually Golden Circle. There's no proof Jesse was a member of it, but it wouldn't shock me if he was, they were extremely secretive. So there's that template, it never had a scale dimensions. And it was just that drawing. And I thought, I don't know how to use this, even with one known location, it's hard to find the scale, you'd have to know where at least two words to make it work. When I had Wagner cars, three locations in George's it fit perfectly with the template, all I had to do was make a transparency of the template, overlay it on Google Earth, and it felt everything fell in line. Wow. And then I work farther from that. It's not just one template. It's a grid of templates. I laid I kept I started working with that worked my way out overlaying in with a grid of overlays over the entire state of Texas went further, it's got about half of America on that the problem with doing the entire country is the curvature of the earth. Again, the way that it kind of distorts the template when you get too far east or west from it. But make a long story short, that template turned into a grid grid system. I knew the dimensions. I wanted to know what okay, why the dimensions who's responsible for this? I get I'm constantly curious about everything. So I kept researching that and that that's what led me down the rabbit hole of secret societies and a lot of other stuff.

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Yeah, I mean, even I've got part of the part of the stuff up right now. From the book talking about the tree of life and how the connections in the Tree of Life match up with the ratios inside of the template and everything else. And it's absolutely fascinating and we just recently had Jason quit on about how literally these these concepts these concept of the Asad everything else from from ancient Hebrew and from Kabbalah tie into so many things and are carried for, like you yourself are a mason though these teachings and truths, and even the geometric truths of them are carried forth even to this day in those teachings. Yeah, and after

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all the research I've done, what, when I won't get into that I probably shouldn't, but that what you're saying is exactly right. And it wasn't just Freemasonry. It's a lot of different mystic traditions from Oh God, the Sufi traditions, just about all of the Jewish traditions, it ties in with Indras. Net, which has, you know, Indras net Indra is, I think she's worshipped by the Hindus, or at least honored and also Buddhists. And the funny thing is Indras. Net is also shown on Aleister Crowley's tarot deck, I think it was the queen card. Don't quote me on that. But there's a lady holding a net, and it looks just like injures names. That's basically the veil template that I might discover. And he turned around and walked off. And I looked at mom like what, who? Who's watching and this is weird. And we just kind of shook our head like, Okay, this is odd. We sit down at the table, and we noticed an old man watching us and there was a young guy who kept coming up to his table, and then he'd run off again with microfiche just scrolling through the microfiche really fast. And we weren't approached that day. It was on another trip like this. We came back I think it was the third trip after that. We were at the archives. There's those same two guys, the old guy, the young guy, David Baskins never mentioned it again. We just made sure we didn't sign the book. They were there watching them.
