It's fantastic. It's put on by Ryan Edwards, our good friend and crypto zoologist there in the area, as well as our friend rod Nichols of Bayer county Bigfoot, so hopefully we will see all of you guys there tomorrow night. Symposium of the strange.com is where you can find out more about that. Our guest in the first segment is the amazing Kathleen ball. She is the the creator of the Docu documentary, Brazilian Templar mystery. She is in the midst of getting ready to release the second one. She just got back from a huge trip to tomar in Portugal, researching the second one and more about the Knights Templar in the second get second slot, we will be talking with Earl Gray, as well as Mike turber about the recent UFO panel and covering that, what it means to the community, what it means for the cause of disclosure. Welcome back for this first segment. Dr Kathleen ball, how have you been doing?

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I've been really great.

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You. Yeah, things that

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you have been around the globe and visiting, visiting all over the place, let's, let's get into a little bit of of your recent trip. What? What? What locations did you get to visit? What things are you able to tell us about that you were able to uncover during that trip? Doctor,

well, I want to kind of back up a little bit, because I went from England, and I had a lecture series in England and London and another location. And then I actually went into France, and I've been collecting what they call Mason marks that have been all over these castles. And, you know, Templar churches, castles, cathedrals all over the place. And nobody can give me a really good explanation for what they are. So I talked to Scott Walter about this, and I told him I thought that I believed it was a some type of code, possibly. And he agreed. So, so that's something that I'm going to be looking into more with him, and I've collected now about 300 but what I did was I went after I just took off a little side trip and went to France. And I went to back to dome and reprotographed more of the graffiti and the markings in where they held the Templars. And I found out they were only held from 1307 to 1310, there. And then they were transferred. Many of them were transferred to Chinon. So I went. Into Chinon as well, and I photographed everything in there and and then I went to sharp cathedral, photographed everything in there, and got another, you know, another collection, unbelievable graffiti and iconography and the Templar, you know, really, really good, sharp Cathedral is a really good example of early Templar construction, and phenomenal. So from there, I also went back into an Moise France, which is where Leonardo da Vinci had lived, and I found out that he actually lived less than two kilometers from the Templar church. And what was interesting about this particular church is that it was dedicated to St John the Baptist. So I was looking, I have been looking for the connection between Leonardo da Vinci and the Templars. And I think I finally found it. He was very interested. Everyone at that time were interested in what the Templars had brought back from Istanbul and from the Holy Land, in terms of esoteric knowledge and wisdom. And many people were apparently practicing alchemy. And it looks like Leonardo Vinci may have been involved in that as well. But this, I think, was what precipitated a lot of the secrets that he put into his artwork, in terms of the sacred geometrical forms and a lot of the secret coding that, you know, there's several people right now. What's that grant? And what's his name? Grant, Robert Edward grant has been really, really decoding a lot of Da Vinci stuff. So, so that was phenomenal. And then, of course, in you know, during that trip, I also discovered numerous crosses that are the vaccine that are in the cave in Brazil that I discovered in 2015 so now I have a collection of crosses. And I went into Royston cave as well. I was in England, and again, I found same crosses that I discovered in the cave. So now I have a collection of places. You know, I've found this, this cross in Brazil, but it's also in it's in France, it's in Spain, it's in Italy, it's in several locations in Portugal. It's in several locations in England and Scotland. And it's also in Istanbul, you know, I had uncovered that one that was in Istanbul as well. So, you know? So now I have, we've been able to push back the dates, and especially as a result of this one church that I went to in Portugal, both trips in March, and then the one I recently got back from about two and a half weeks ago, that church has that cross in repetition on the altar inside, and that church was built between 1040 and 1090 so unable to push back the gates, possibly as early as you know, 1090 I mean, it looks like anytime between 1090 and 1315, or 1312, it looks like was When the tempest row over there in Brazil and dug out that cave, wow, and left graffiti and the interior the cave. So that's huge, that is. It's a huge move forward with my research, and I'm really pleased about that Well,



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and a huge changing of the date, as far as, yeah, but discovery over there, you know, and exploration had



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been right. I've been chipping away at the state little by little. You know, when I interviewed the Columbia a couple of years ago, the calendar the people that they were in the on the slave ships. They had been captured in Africa and brought over to Brazil, the Portuguese and Spanish slave ships. And they jumped ship when they, you know, when they got close to shore, they jumped ship and swam, and they took off, and they went into the area where I discovered the cave. And they stayed in these caves so that pushed the gates back. You know that? That because they said when they arrived in these caves, these Templar caves that were already there, which crosses on them, in the graffiti inside, they were already in there, had been there for a long time. Yeah, so I had, I had pushed that back. And then, you know, the Amazonian tribal native talk of a time when, when the Templars apparently came, but they don't, you know, they can't. They don't give they don't live by dates. You know, they live by a different kind of. It's even difficult for us to wrap our heads around time frame they, they sing it in terms of Joe. Generations, you know, of people. And so all they could tell me was that they knew that the Templars had been through the Amazon, and sometime, you know, several generations ago. Yeah, so I had been chipping away little by little by little, but now I've got some really strong, solid evidence that we have some dates, and we can take the dates back now to, like I said, all the way back to 1090 from 1090 to sometime between there and 1312 they were definitely over there in Brazil. That is,



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that is absolutely incredible. And to know that you you have once again begun pushing that date back now, then, when discovering this, when uncovering these things. Kathleen, how, how reticent are people to share them? Is it more finding documents from families, things like that? Because I mean that, I guess that's what a lot of people don't understand. Is the the familial connection across Europe with the Knights Templar and the fact of you know, it was kind of like giving, giving your son to the seminary, so to speak, at the time. So it was, I mean, one of the, one of the main reasons Leonardo da Vinci would have had connection with them is because of his connection to the Medici family, things like that.

Exactly. Yeah, exactly. And we found evidence. I've been working with Hamilton white as well. We have Jack Easter on this tour with me in October. And I one of the things I did while I was in England, and three days with him, and he and I just, you know, did solid research for three, three solid days. We just knuckle down, and he opened up all the relics that he has, and we have evidence of the very first king in Portugal used the Medici there's a specific number of balls of circle forms that that he incorporated into his coat of arms that were that shows that he

had a background or some relationship with the Medici family. Now we do know now that the very first king of Portugal was matched the count of his wife's son, that is another thing that is coming forth, you know, that's being uncovered now. He was actually the son of the count Templar guard, his first man, Templar guard. So this this son, his real son, his natural son, died about eight years old, and he had severe disabilities. He was warrant. He was born with prejudice. Legs fused. So they had been training this young man to take a risk, King, and this was all done on the fly, secretive, but so what? So now, what we have to do is find out who that first in arms. You know that first guard, what his name was? As we haven't been able to figure that out yet. We haven't gotten down to that, but I suspect that when we do, there's going to show the connection to the Medici family.

No no with this cave in Brazil, having having pushed the date back. Do you know how long their travels to Brazil were? Have you have you come across any documentation of that? How many times they traveled over there, when they stopped traveling over there. Did they stop traveling over there?



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What we've been able to find is on my trip to Portugal in March, I specifically went over there to consult with a fellow researcher, Mario Bella Pedro, who lived into me. She was born and raised in this little coast of town called panic a port. Anyway, come to find out that there's two commanderies in panache ancient commanderies that were Templar commanderies. There were also convents that were used to teach the naval nautical skills to the incoming Templars. And we did some research and found out that every single one of the naval admirals lived in Tunis for 300 years. So we know that the Navy was based there. We think that this was utilized as a secret port, and it dates back to the 11th century. Wow, wow. Yeah, this is phenomenal. I mean, this is huge. So what it appears, and then you have to keep in mind that when all of the Okay. When, when the Templars came back after they loved the fall of actor in 1290 when everybody came back from the Holy Land, all of the monarchs in Europe were broke, all of them, except the King of portsville. And the reason that he still has money is because the Templars grown back and forth to Brazil and Peru, and bringing that back, his coffers were sold, but they his coffers were filled with both gold and silver, silver from Peru and gold from Brazil. Wow. And that, that explains why the Portuguese at that time, you know, and all the way up into the 14 and 1500s I mean, they had, they had, you know, all the money. I mean, they, they were rich. They had, they had all the money. And they were building ships, and they had a navy fleet, and they were building all these amazing buildings and castles, and all over port, Portugal was flourishing when all the other countries were scrambling for money. I mean, we saw what King Francis. I mean, king felt the fair did, yeah, you know, he was so desperate that he that he, you know, faced out the Jews and had the, had the Templars oppressed because he was sober up. He needed money. Yeah, they had someone. It is in England, you know, with Edward the third I mean, Edward didn't do that. He didn't suppress the Templars. But, I mean, he was scrambling for money. All the monarchs were broke. That's why we didn't see, that's why we didn't see any more crusades after that. Yeah, yeah. They just dropped because they were broke. They couldn't afford it. They couldn't, you know, they couldn't afford to support another crusade, yeah, and

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you know what? It's interesting, because so much curiosity is there about where the Templars went. Did they leave to Portugal and find safe harbor in Portugal? Because, of course, the King of France levied charges against them of heresy. Had them, had them famously burned at the stake, captured, killed, all kinds of things, mainly because they would not help him round up the Jewish people of France to wipe their debt to him clean, or his debt to them clean. He was like, I can gladly get a whole bunch of money. Just help me round up these people and take all their belongings and I'll give it to you, and then we'll be square, right?

Yeah. And what happened? What happened, Chris, is that it was just the opposite the Templars. What people don't realize Templars, you know? I mean, this was phenomenal that when Freddie felt Silva published that book at Temple nation, that was, yeah, first Temple nation study really got even, like a little glimpse. It was really going on in Portugal. What was really going on in Portugal is Portugal was a template that what the Templars agenda is, what I've uncovered. They were, they developed. They conquered the Moors and Islam and invited them to stay. And they had the Druids, they had the Druze, they had ink, they had Christians, they had Jews. They had every nationality and spiritual belief system, religious people with religious backgrounds, all living in Portugal. And what they did when King Francis, I mean, when King Philip went after the Jews in France, they rescued him and took him into into Portugal. Same thing with Cathars. Yeah, I found evidence of Cathars all across Portugal, Cathars crosses and evidence, historical evidence, of the Cathars having, you know, masses of property, mass lions in Portugal that the Templars gave them.

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But this, this, this this work in Brazil, though, and especially the setting back of the date to 1090 Kathleen changes so much of what we know of the Knights Templar and so much of the story, because, I mean, so much of the story is the fact that they, they made their bones and got their money in the First Crusade, protecting pilgrims and basically being a bank that protected your cash on the way over there, things like that. And for a small percentage, we'll give you a note, and when you get there we'll give you your gold and all that kind of good and that's how they made their money. Aside from donation from very, very rich family,

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they had a bigger they had a larger agenda that most people don't realize. And I when I was in England, I did a lot of research on the records, and found out that the Templars were embedded in the whole governmental system in England, also Germany, in France, and they own, I mean, portu. Was a template nation, there was no doubt about it, and what it was Portugal was actually a pilot program for what they wanted to see happen throughout the rest of Europe and eventually the rest of the rest of the world. Now, when they went before they went into the holy land, they organized in Greece, and they were also in Constantinople, and they were gathering esoteric belief system, any kind of paperwork that get, any kind of scrolls, any kind of document. Now, they were initiated under the Druze and Sufi. So they were very

familiar with all the initiation processes. What they had intended to do was go back into Europe, into the main area of mainland in Europe, start this country, in Portugal, as a template for what they wanted to do was bring about this change, this this Enlightenment period, this period of enlightenment, and share all of this esoteric knowledge with the masses. Well, it was bad timing, because that's when the Catholic Church was just getting going. And of course, you know, we now have the Inquisition and everything else was happening, but they were able to get involved with inside in the countries, they were the bankers for all the monarchs, every single one of them, I found that they were, they bank every single one of the monarchs and all of the noble families throughout the whole entire continent of Europe and into the UK. So what it tells me is that when they were traveling, they were setting, I think that they were setting intentions, if you want to put it that way, in other countries, to eventually branch out into these other countries and eventually bring this New idea of a world, a new world, I guess you would call it of harmony, of equality into this is what they wanted to do, is bring this into existence. This is why they teamed up with Bernard de Cabo, because Barnard de Cabo was the head of the assertion movement. And what that movement was about was to clean out the corruption in the Catholic Church. So they were trying, I think at some point, they were trying to actually clean up the Catholic Church, and at the same time, you know, bring about this ideal, that they had this agenda, that they had to bring about a better world based on these esoteric belief systems that they had uncovered while they were in Greece, in Constantinople and in the Holy Mass. And I'm, I firmly believe this now and then later. You know, they were involved in the Magna Carter and they, and that, of course, is what them, that's, that's what you know, our, our rules and laws over here in United States are based on. So I didn't, which was brought, you know, of course, the Masons. That was, that was there the Masons, baby. But who were the Masons? The Masons studied the Templar initiation. They did all the same initiations of that's what the Templars had. They had all the same beliefs that were passed down. If they weren't, you know, descendants of Templar families, they certainly were understudies of the Templars belief systems and, you know, ideals. And United States of America was built on a foundation that was initially inspired by the Templars,

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yeah, yeah. And by that, once again, cause of enlightenment, and the idea of inclusion of all religions and all religious thought, you know, the consideration of the capital G, Creator God, not, not the Judeo, Christian God, things like that. And even the idea of the unfinished pyramid being what it represented for them, which is the idea of, you know, it's that it's never finished, because your temple is never finished, you should be learning till the day you die. You know the idea that the esoteric concept behind that right

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individual evolution, as you know, in addition to collective consciousness rising and consciousness evolution, you know, Nam time on a collective level as well as an individual level. So, you know, to this is ongoing, and they were well aware of this. And you know, I've also had several conversations with Timothy Hogan, which had been very enlightening. And found out, you know, that my research when I went back in. To the second building of the temple in Jerusalem in 600 and something BC. Their ruble bowl organized the Banda nights to protect the builders of that temple. And so I had uncovered in Portugal it looked like one of the families with the same families that originated, that were the origin of the timbers in 1118, so

we think that they're the same. And Timothy agreed with me. He said, Yeah, they're absolutely the same. Explain why they knew exactly where to go. I mean, we have these Nine Nights, which I found that there was actually 11. We have these 11 nights that all came from Ashland families, wealthy families. And here they go into Jerusalem, and they couldn't stay in the castle. But why they didn't stay in the castle? Where'd they stay? They stayed in the dilapidated stables. Why? Because they were right directly under, over the top of where the Temple Mount. And the first thing they did was to build a tunnel, dig out a tunnel, and excavate that whole area underneath the Temple Mount. So I think that you know generation talking about passing things down generationally, this is what happened. And I firmly believe that many of the same families that they're livable put together as knights to protect the builders. They would have been, of course, they would have been pretty to your whole entire architectural design at that point, they were protecting these builders. So, you know it, it makes a perfect sense that these things would have been passed down to their descendants. And then, of course, you know that when they get the chance to go to the Holy Land, what's the first thing they do? They go right down into the, you know, right down into stables and underneath the Temple Mount. So, yeah, yeah, precisely.



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And, you know, it even the fact of like you were saying, because, of course, most people would be like, once again, 1119, that was, that was the founding of the Knights Templar, you know. But this information that you're talking about caves and things going back to 1090 that that changes everything Kathleen, that's a that's almost 100 years. That is a large because once again, people think that they were, they were like a hobbled group of brother knights and things like that, that they didn't really have a lot of power, that they amassed this power during, like, Okay, if they did that, then they just, like sprung into power, is what happened. And and if you have from 1090 till then to quietly assemble and do what you're gonna do, and have families, you know, give fortune and and sons to the cause, quietly, then, yeah, you've had almost 100 something, almost 100 years to amass this army, and he amassed this power, and amassed the knowledge enough and and the Navy enough even to go to Brazil to mount that



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expedition. Remember that you know the king in Portugal, King Dennis, at the time that King Philip the fair rounded everybody up in France. I'm beginning to see what I'm what my research is showing me is that, you know, France appears to be the the the facade, or the the facade, power structure of the Templars. You know, there's everybody thought that that was the primary headquarters. I think that the primary headquarters was actually in Portugal. I think the power was in Portugal, and what the nuts and bolts and what was really going on in terms of furthering their agenda to bring about a better world. That was all in Portugal, and they were furthering that all the way back to 290 you know, I firmly believe that they're back and forth. Now, I'm covered some research that some people in the Azores. There's a old family in the Azores, and apparently there's some records of one of the family members that was a Templar leaving the A's, or sometime in the 11th or 12th century. Excuse me, early 12th century, beginning of 1100s and following the path of the crows into South America, the immigration path. Now I'm I haven't been able to find anything else on this, except for this one document that that we've uncovered over there, but it makes sense, and it shows a much earlier

departure than you know, that one has been, that one's been accepted by these. Historic record. So, you know, there's just, there's just everything pointing to a much earlier date, and everything pointing to the fact that what was really the most, the most important things that were happening within the Templar movement were happening in Portugal, not necessarily in France,

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that is, that is so, so interesting, and once again, changes the face of what we know about the temple and the date range.

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Typically, they're not, you know, they're not a people that that, you know, walks down and, you know, beats the drum and tells everybody who they are. You know, that's typically just not who they are anyway, yeah, and, and from what, what we're finding out is the king kept this knowledge of South America secret for several 100 years. He told all the other monarchs. He told everybody else that that South America that wasn't even known, that word that wasn't even known. He led to everybody to believe that he had a ship that went out and they discovered an island, and they called the island Veracruz, so that nobody suspected there was a Nair cont met, yeah, that is, in the meantime, he's got whole fleets going over there, back and forth, back and forth, back and forth, bringing back gold, bringing back silver. And also he, he managed the monarchs in Portugal. You know, they were, if you look at that time frame, then the building, and all the things that were going on at that time. I mean, they were, they had, they must have had, what would be equivalent to billions of dollars, you know, today, in today's money, that they that they had access to and were continually putting it into buildings and naval fleets and, you know, everything else,

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yeah, because one way,

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they were barely, you know, they were barely supporting the Crusades, you know. And like I said, when after the fall of actor, I mean, they were dead broke.

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Well, was this going on during the time of the Crusades as well? Have you been able to track that?

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Yeah, yeah. During the Crusades, you know, in Portugal, at least, they was they were traveling. They were traveling by ship. Area, we found evidence looks like this is later evidence, though, but it appears there's, there's some Templar Knights of Christ crosses on a port in India that I haven't seen personally, but I'm going to be going older to see that I've been told about. And I have pictures were sent to me, so I have some photos. And so, you know, I mean, they were, they were traveling all over the place, Chris, all over the place. They were in North America. We know that, you know, we know that the Sinclair family, they they supported a couple of trips over to North America and, and this was on the 13th, probably 13th century, no excuse me, 14th century, but early in the 1300s and we have what I think, Scott molter has a date of 1323, or something like that, I Think, anyway. And, you know, and he's doing some phenomenal research right now too, my God, but he's opened up on this last episode that they had, but he had the chin C Hogan Secrets of the Night temper. It's out on YouTube. My God, that access that he had uncovered and decoded, he was able to find the cipher and decode these, all of this, all these documents. And, I mean, these are phenomenal. These are absolutely phenomenal. So this agenda that they have had dates way back before they were ever organized, this agenda to bring about a world, and, you know, of equality that goes much further back. And so they were inspired by these original documents, these original texts and things that they uncovered. But, yeah, there's just some great stuff coming out, right? You know, in the next, I perceive the next, you know, 50 years, 20 years maybe. I mean, we're gonna completely overturn a lot of things that we've, you know, typically believed were history that are not, they're not facts



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Well, and that's just it. We are regularly changing that. Um. Um, so, so many things history wise, have been have been pushed back. Dates have been pushed back. Things have utterly changed. I mean, even the even the the concept of when, when feet first hit North America natively, has changed in the last couple of years. So, right. So the ideas of once again, that Native Americans in that area talk about having met knights, Templar, things like that. The ideas of them having come to America, having come to South America



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symbol. I mean, if you look on some of their older pottery, you see temper crosses for christ sake, and they're even red, you know. So you know this the same thing that the same story that I get from the Amazonian tribes in South America and Brazil, same story, they shared an initiation, they shared, they probably shared ayahuasca, for all we know and you know, but they definitely shared symbolism, they shared ideology. They were definitely compatible with each other enough to where the Amazonians were the ones that brought the Templars from Bahia into Al Capone.



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No, so what? What would they have aside from gold, things like that. Because, once again, if they were carrying this on during the crusade as well, um, did they have ulterior plans aside from just bringing gold back for the king things like that.

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Well, I think that they were, you know, basically stashing money away for a time, an opportunity when they could actually fund their dream, you know. And I really think, you know, I personally believe, and I know a lot of people are gonna really not probably want to hear it, but I personally believe that, you know, the treasure in all kinds was used, and it was Templar treasure, I believe it was used during the Revolutionary War. That

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is the first time that I have heard that hypothesis put forth.

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Yeah, well, I'm not the only one, right? The hypothesis has been scored by a number of people. I think Scott is even on board with that one. And, you know, and it just makes sense to me. I would, you know, when something doesn't ring true to me, for whatever reason, I'm, you know, I'm always on board with what is logically sensible, what makes sense, what human nature, you know, what, what people are going to do, and if they're and if they had conceived this idea of creating a nation here in the United States of America, you know, with the Bill of Rights and all These things that that mirror the Magna Carta, right? Do you think that they would have forgot about how they were going to fund it? No, that would have been, that would have been an integral piece of the plan. And I think that you know that they had, I think Nate a lot of this money that funded the Revolutionary War. I know we got a lot of money from France as well. But I think it was probably Templar, Templar treasure that did it, that funded a lot of that

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well. And you know, when you start looking at specifically the countries involved with funding, the United States, it makes a lot, it makes a lot of sense, you know, they were, they were definitely countries heavily tied to, to tip LA, right?

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Exactly. I mean, you know, look, we got the sketch ability from France, you know, and, and I think that's why all eyes are on us right now. They want to see what's going to happen, you know, with with the democracy, is it going to survive this? What's going on right now? Well, that's remains to be seen. We have survived for two, over 200 years. So, you know, I mean, it stands to, well, stands reason that we will, and we're going to go through an uphill which we need to. We needed to anyway. We really, you know, this country is at that point where, you know, we need to shake things up. Things need to be shaken up, you know, shaken up. So we're gonna get a shake up.

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Well, and you know, it's there. There's a reason why the Founding Fathers called it the great experiment. You know it is. It is an ongoing experiment. The experiment never stops, because through through observation and through gathering of data, we come up with more hypotheses and and change the equation all the time. Kathleen evolving,

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if he's. Solving species evolved, you know? And that's the beauty of you know, that's the beauty of this country, and that's the beauty of the founders, that what they foresaw for this country, there's a continual evolutionary process, then we would shift and change and allow for that to take place and unfold organically, you know. So I think, you know, I'm just sitting back and I'm, I'm wondering, you know, and I'm waiting to see what kind of changes are going to take place and, and I believe in, you know? Because, you know, I mean, I've always had a very firm belief in our Creator, you know, my personal belief is, you either you should or get off the pot. You either believe that there's a God that has all power, or you don't. Do believe that the God that has all power, well, then you believe that there's a plan, and that that plan is unfolding, and it may not make any flipping sense to us. I'm sure it didn't make any sense to Anne Boleyn when she was getting beheaded. But I'll tell you what, if it hadn't been for Anne Boleyn, she was absolutely pivotal, and what happened later? Yeah, with the Enlightenment probably, probably

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didn't make a lot of sense to Jackie Malay at the time,

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he can't talk about him. He can say that they're there because, well, he signed a document. There's a legal document that could be found, you know, it's in a skiff, so it can be, it can be found through FOIA requests, the document that he signed. But that's even something else that was gotten into is, is the the denial of and blocking of FOIA requests, you know that was heavily brought up, heavily brought up, and hugely important, you know, to to be made known publicly. 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I was saying I've been pretty lucky with my foyer requests. Green Greenwald is bent head, look, head, look. And then he would run up against a stone wall. And a lot of had to do with terminology and knowing exactly where to look, not necessarily what to look for, and that became an issue. But with Lou's books, his book coming through dobster and his, you know,

releasing of information inside. Of his book and being told what he can and can't talk about borderlines. You know, some, some questions have to be raised when he answers the question that he was asked at that meeting. And we'll get, I guess we'll get into that. If you have that clip,

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yeah, we'll, we'll get, we'll get to that clip, most definitely. And you know, as somebody swimming hip deep in the UFO UAP community, role, what has been, what has been your overall reception of how people have taken this in I,

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they always will, but, you know,

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I mean, I didn't expect anything like this, but he's doing it,

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and that's just it. You know, even even hearing from gold, who used to work at NASA, now works for red fly aerospace, things like that, even hearing from him about the ridicule the NASA

works for red pill aerospace, things like that, even hearing from him about the ridicule the NASA scientists once they started getting involved because, yeah, like, at the second NASA panel, the head had to get up beforehand to be like, Okay, Guys, seriously. Are we going to be like threatening NASA scientists on social media, like you can't, you can't, for decades, say that we aren't willing to be involved and aren't willing to investigate, and then once we get into the investigation, start saying that we are part of an all consuming conspiracy and hate us, you know, like, it doesn't encourage scientists who want to be involved with your cause. Yeah, it doesn't help the



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social media and internet is definitely a battlefield that is not for the faint of heart. Yeah, no, yeah. A lot of times when people are injected into that with a with a very solid background and, you know, in the scientific community and what have you. And it's very difficult to try to you almost want to take someone that's going to venture out into the social media world and say, Listen, here is a premier course you need to go through to learn how to handle these people when they come out. And unfortunately that you know, they have to learn the hard way, I guess. And it's not good. It's not conducive for what we're trying to accomplish. Well,



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well, and also, neither is continued classification and that that is literally our first clip is from Senator groffman talking about the need to declassify these things, and the fact of many of them are well beyond the time that they should have been declassified and been. Been available to an oversight panel, been available for congressional review, that kind of stuff, so that their constituents could be aware of it and of where their money went, all that.
