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to know that there are many cases of literal, hidden messages in people's real time speech. This isn't like something that's put in in post production. This isn't something that's done in a recording studio. Nobody's being trained in how to live embed reverse speech while they speak. No, okay, it's not, it's not done intensely. No one's been trained to do it. Let me just squash those rivers on the head right now. It is a natural form of language. Everyone's doing it. You're doing it, not doing it. Your listeners to the show are doing it. You know, it's just light breathing, yeah, they're all delivering reverse messages now. Those pillars of faith are literally what, what were the divining rod as to what books stayed in the Bible, and it didn't matter which sect you were regionally, if you were reading the Gospel of Mary, it's out now. Sorry, yeah. And if you keep reading it, you're going to be out with it. We're you're now anathema, you know. And welcome to becoming Eastern Orthodox, right? So, so you want to make sure that in the guise of worshiping



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and following the teachings of Jesus, you want to be careful that you're really, not really worshiping the Emperor, yeah, yeah, no matter who that Emperor is, well, well, or whoever is controlling the dialog and and, you know, as you were talking a second ago, the the one, the one scripture that popped into my head was, don't be lukewarm. And it like, this whole path of my show and even my audience and everything, like, people ask me all the time, like, why aren't you more popular? Like, I can't like the guests you have, the topics you I don't understand why you aren't more popular. And I was like it I've as I've told them numerous times. It's because I am not infrared or ultraviolet.



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It's I am, I am purple. I'm in the middle. I My job is, my job is to be, I'm not popular to you, my I'm pretty popular. My job is to be passionately lukewarm Reverend,

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which means I'm not going to be hot or cold, because if I'm hot or cold, then I'm being driven by a dialog one way or another. Yeah, I can't see it. I can't see it from the middle. I'm being I'm being pulled by a dialog, at that point, being pulled by a narrative. And that's not demystifying things, which is what this show is about, kind of like we're breaking down Project Blue Beam and how it would be used to control people right now, you know, not in a panic kind of way, but in a let's demystify this and get to the root of why it would work. And we're making, we're letting people make their own decisions. That's it. That's it. Once again, the idea of the profit, there's a way out. There's a way out. It's not just a foregone conclusion. There's a way out. If the Prophet doesn't give you a way out, that's why. That's why. No, Strada is sitting a prophet, y'all. All he did was scry some stuff, which, sure, there may be some accuracies in there, but a prophet gives you an option where it's like, hey, you know, if you stop doing this, this isn't gonna happen. Yes, yeah, yeah, yeah, well, and that's, and that's very, and you know what, thank God you said it.

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That is very, very crucial, ladies and gentlemen, because you can read revelations.

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And.

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Are you revelations? There are ways to keep that from happening.

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I don't believe we've reached a point of no return, at least not yet. I think we're close. Think we're close with climate change and even with are we as a country? What choices are we going to make? And history will, will, that'll play out. But you, and it's not just, and what you said, Chris, it's not just that

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prophecies give you a way out.

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Love gives you a way out, right, love and empathy. And if you say, God is love, as John talks

about,

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then you always have a way out. You may suffer some bumps and bruises, but love gives you a way out.

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And so I guess that's the bottom line. I'm not talking about love being mushy and Oh, I love it. I love it. I'm not talking about that kind of love. We that may not even be love, but I am talking about the love that says there's nothing you can do that, that I will I can't unlove you. You have free will, though, yeah, and free will simply means that you can do anything you want, anything, as long as you know you have to face the consequences. Yeah, that's that's free will, that that that used to be, that used to be the joke that we played on each other in the seminary all the time. It's just like, hey, you know that's a sin, right? Well, you do now, yeah, yeah, I've been for your conscience now, yeah, now you got a problem otherwise. Otherwise, we're just sinners judging other sinners for sending different Well, well, and you know the really, you know, yeah, yeah, no, personally, I don't want to do that. Well, well, when you mentioned, you mentioned something in our pre show conversation, Reverend, the the idea of viewing the world through a jaundiced eye, you know, the idea of looking at the world through a tainted filter, yeah, you know. And I see this back in your eye, but not the log in mine. Yeah, yeah, as, as a famous rabbi once said. And so when we go back to things like Project Blue Book, you know, test the spirit. Test the spirit well. And for you, you throw your before you throw your your whole weight behind it, that's right. And, and What? What? What spawned this whole combo? What spawned my text to you, Reverend, about this was because I've been aware of Bluebeam for a long time. I've done a few episodes. We've mentioned Bluebeam a few times in our conversations on air.

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However, I have seen it brought up in news cycle.

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I've seen it as I'm popping up different sources. Like, here it is from, you know, indie TV. Here it is from Newsweek, like it's it's popping up all over the place to see it. And

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oddly enough, the conversation that I hear it from in the community, more than anything, is people in the UFO UAP community who identify as religious. Yeah. And and what, what disturbs me the most is the fact of not only are they saying it and saying, Look at Project Blue Beam in action, but they're forgetting the fact that it's there to possibly fake, something to catalyze the religious right, something to catalyze the faithful and the religious, and it's like, my god, have

you taken the plank out of your eye? Are you seeing, literally, how they are using this to catalyze you right now? Yeah, yes, yes. And that's a great point. That's a great point, and because what we're seeing with this whole militarization of the narrative, yeah, they will get to define who the enemy is. That's right now. I now, even if it's each other, even if it's us, yeah, yeah. But I mean, you know that too. But I mean even as you know, pickpocket walks into a room, walks into a party, and all these seasons, or she sees his pockets. The thing is this, I when I see, from what I hear and read, of nuclear facilities being monitored and they shut off the nuclear missiles, I don't see that as a threat. I see that maybe as a warning. I see that maybe even as an act of friends saying, you really don't know what you're doing with this. Because, let's face it, if something was going to happen, it would have happened already. That's right



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by them versus us. Yeah, they'd have launched them all and raised the planet to begin with. But, but, but if I keep telling you it's a threat, if I keep telling you you're.
