And that's part of the thing that rom brings up in the pre record spot, is that, you know, it's gonna get to a point where all of these terminologies just break down, much like the speed of light, like, as you approach that, things just like start breaking down in physics, you know, the equation no longer equates, and we it's it's interesting. And our guest in the first segment, I'm very, very happy to welcome tonight, renario Ray Hernandez folks, he is with a great, I'm sorry, a greater reality.com. Is the website his book, one of many books. Part one of six is the mind of God, a spiritual virtual Virtual Reality model of consciousness and contact modalities, that is what we are having Ray on to discuss tonight, is the world of concept modalities. What are concept modalities and how do they relate

to the overall conversation of not just UFO, UAP Ray, but so many other topics of the paranormal. Welcome to the show for the first time. How are you doing this evening? Ray, thank you for the invitation. Absolutely. Thank you for joining us from Columbia tonight. You are. You're literally coming from half a globe away. So welcome, welcome. How are things down there?

Crazy, crazy now. Ray, when, when you began your work and your PhD doctoral work on contact modalities, and began the first part of the mind of God? What? What was it that brought you to this research to begin with?

Well, I, I started off as a skeptic of all of this phenomenon. Had zero knowledge, zero interest, and then I had a paranormal experience with my ex wife where an energy being appeared in our living room and totally. Heal our paralyzed dog, who we were going to be euthanizing later that afternoon. Wow, and and that was jointly in the experience with my ex wife and I. And then she began to pray outside to the being that healed our dog, and UFOs would show up. So then I started doing it, and UFOs would show up as well very large objects, and most of these were the size of a football field. They were not physical. And then I began having almost every type of paranormal experiences, out of body experiences, astral travel experiences, seeing shadow beams in the house, having precognition of things that are going to happen, yeah? I mean, tons of paranormal related experiences, yeah. And then I've had lots of synchronized, orchestrated events, okay, that's one way you could call them. And I'll skip, skip over a year and a half of these experiences, and go straight to one day where I had driving my car in the middle of a traffic jam, I was taken out of my body into another multi dimensional reality, and I was shown what is consciousness and all of the paranormal, that they're all interrelated, and it's all one phenomenon. So for example, you this guest that you're going to be having in your next session. We have in our great reality book series, we have authors in our various chapters that are the world's foremost authorities under your death experiences. We have articles by Raymond Moody. We have articles by by Doctor Jeffrey long. This is Doctor Rudy shields, professor from Harvard. Doctor Jeffrey long has written three books on near death experiences. He's been collecting data on Mt ease for over 40 years. Michael Grosso is a professor of philosophy from Columbia University and and there's myself and and there's a book, volumes one and volumes two. Each of them are 800 pages. As you can see, this long list of PhD academics and medical doctors, yeah. And if you scroll to the top of this list, for example, a little bit more up. Mm, hmm. Okay, there. Edgar Mitchell Apollo, 14 astronaut, yep. Was one of the co founders of the doctor Edgar Mitchell Free Foundation, and I was one of the co authors of that book, which I'm going to discuss in a couple of minutes. Right next to him is Doctor Bruce

Grayson, and he is one of the world's leading authorities on near death experiences. He just recently retired from the University of Virginia School of Medicine. We also have up there in that list, Dr Raymond Moody. We have Dr Evan Alexander, a professor of neurosurgery at Harvard, who had a profound near death experiences. And I could go on and on with this list. There's Raymond Moody at the end, all the way to the right. So our organization has the world's leading authorities on on near death experiences. And if I could argue, before I begin my session, here is that the NDE is the key to understand the UFO Contact phenomenon. Why? Because consciousness is fundamental. All those people on that list, you go down that whole list, okay, all those people believe that consciousness is fundamental and that our perceived physical reality is an illusion, okay? And that's Raymond Moody, thinks that same way. Doctor Jeffrey Mishlove, everyone that's on that list, okay, and that, that all of the paranormal needs to be viewed as one integrated phenomenon under consciousness. And so from that basic teaching of my out of body experience, I was returned after about an hour, and then immediately, within two days, I was introduced to Mary Rodwell, a UFO Contact researcher in Australia, to Dr woody shields, a professor of astrophysics from Harvard University, and Dr Edgar Mitchell, who's at The home of Dr Edgar Mitchell on the third day where the DR Edgar Mitchell Free Foundation research study began, and after five years of collecting data, because we wound up with over 15 PhD academics in that research study, after Five years, we published an 820 page book titled beyond UFOs, the science of consciousness and contact with non human intelligence. 820 pages. If you go to our website, if you click on Books, you'll see that is one of the books. Now mind you for all your audience members. Years. That's a book of my personal experiences. But there's that's the book right there beyond UFOs, the science of consciousness and contact with non human intelligence. As you can see, the co authors on the bottom is myself, the Harvard professor, Dr Rudy shields and Doctor John clemo, a retired professor of psychology for over 45 years and 820 pages, and that book is the world's first and only comprehensive academic statistical research study on UFO Contact experiences. And the data from that book totally contradicts what is circulating in Main Street, materialist ufology. Now that book is free. It's free. Go to that website. You can download a PDF copy of it, okay, so that book is free, and all the other books that are there, they're all free. Okay, see, download the book right there. The reason is because what we found totally contradicts what is circulating in ufology. It was close to 60% of these people were having out of body experiences seeing a ghost. Was like 80% of them saw a ghost. Okay? And being brought to a multi, multi dimensional reality, like I was, I was 50% of the people okay, having seen the dead person. Okay? Huge numbers, yeah. And the reason for all of this is because if you talk to major contact experiences like myself, they will tell you that they've not only seen a UFO, they've had out of body experiences. They've had Malta astral travel experiences. Okay, they've seen that people. They've seen shadow beam. There was a period I was seeing shadow beam, you know, several times a week, squeaking, you know, right across me in the back when I was doing zoom calls. So the and also how these people changed? Oh, my goodness. People that were atheists all have become deeply spiritual, okay? People that fear death, they no longer fear death. People that were humble, horrible odors, all of a sudden, a loving light, and you're not very loving, yeah? And illustrations of this are two well known people, okay? One is Whitney Strieber. Whitney streamer started off with all the horrors of the alien abduction phenomena. Now he prays to the beings that interacted with him. He considers them angels. Okay, that's Whitney Strieber. His last book, last three books have been about God and the afterlife.

Okay, so those are just two examples that people know about, but we literally have 4000 Oh, absolutely that went through that transition. And so I also have articles in there of what we learned about the. Whole contact phenomena, we have a summary of that book Beyond UFOs, if you don't want to read 820, pages, we have a summary of the data and a very, very detailed summary. And so naturally, I was never invited to these UFO conferences. All of these articles here are from volumes one and two of our greater reality book series. Now these are all theoretical articles one and two, and each volume is 800 pages. Now this book the mind of God. That's the introduction to our six volume book series. Uh, volumes one and two are theoretical in nature, and you'll see all those academics that you'll saw those pictures of. Yeah, they wrote articles for volumes one and two. Now, volumes 345, and six are articles written by major experiences of the contact modalities. They're not listed there. They're listed in the in the books, in the book section, okay, yeah, where it says all the way at the top, yeah, where it says books and articles. That's a book about my personal experiences. This is the beyond UFOs. That's the introduction to the great reality book series. And here, here's volumes one and two. This book is 800 pages. And Volume Two, which follows it afterwards, is also 800 pages. These are theoretical. And then if you scroll down, these are now experiencer written chapters. These books are also 800 pages. And if you table go to the table of contents. A little bit more at the bottom right there, go there. Table of Contents. Okay, you will see a very brief summary of some of these people go down a little bit more. Okay, right there. Doctor Belinda Greer, go a little bit right there. Okay. She's a recently retired medical doctor. She has seen 14 UFOs. She's seen three Sasquatch experiences, two of them very up close, one of them lasting the entire night. She has had two near death experiences, her second nd, which is totally unbelievable, extremely powerful. She's had out of body experiences. She's been brought to other dimensions. She sees deceased people and a whole boatload of paranormal experiences. So this is a recently retired medical doctor who's been quiet all of her life, and this article is the first attempt for her to come out of the closet. The second person under there is also a retired medical doctor, Dr Joseph Brooks. He's been doing CE five since 1992 we see the whole boatload of UFOs, one of them we discussed, we compared notes, because I told him these were holographic projections. And he told me of an experience where he saw a world war one wooden airplane, but it didn't have the three layers of wings, only one wing. It was bitty, winning wings, a little, tiny wings, not even, you know, five feet across. And he looked up and it didn't have a pilot, and it was running parallel to him on the highway at like, 60 miles an hour. Wow. And so he concluded that this is impossible. A World War one airplane painted in bright fire engine red, with no pilot, with little bitty wings, you couldn't hear a noise, no noise at all. He said, This is not real. This had to be a holographic projection. And I told him, that's the exact conclusion that I reached based upon many of my experiences, one of my experiences, I will go back to my very first UFO that I called down, and that was very, very detailed experience. Lots of stuff happens in that experience, but basically my friends came and they began to try to explain the way of what they were seeing. These are hundreds of oblong streaks of light that formed like a whole huge skeleton. It was like six football fields in length, a football field in height. It was enormous. There's things right on top of us. And so then they began to try to explain it away. And after two minutes, I busted out laughing, and I told the intelligence behind the UFO, because I called it down. In 15 minutes, it appeared after I called it down. So in my mind, I said, and this is verbatim, I said, You better come up with some better bullshit than this, because my friends don't believe you. Instantaneously, what we were watching totally disappeared and now replaced by like, 50 huge orbs the size of Volkswagen Beetles, very, very close to the ground, okay? And they were all going on and off, on and off. The orbs on and off, on and off, like, like, behind the bicycle. You see those bicycles that go on and off like that. Yes, that. These are huge orbs. Okay, so then my friends and me. Easily stop trying to explain it away, because this was, you can't explain that way, and it was a totally different object from what I first said. And so Joseph, Joseph Burks, Doctor Joseph Burks and I were comparing notes, and we both came up with the hypothesis that these are holographic projections that people were saying, Okay, now same thing with the beans that people are seeing, overwhelming majority of people that see these beings, and they're literally 10s of 1000s of different types of beings. There's a friend of mine in Miami. Goodness, my Alzheimer's is kicking in. He's written 16 books. Each book has, like, 300 pages of different UFO Contact, experiential stories with different types of beings. And

they're all different, you know, from robots to elephant heads to like buddy buddy rabbits to fish heads to all the typical UFO beings that people associate with and and that's what in our survey, we literally had, in for a book Beyond UFOs, we literally had 10s of 1000s of different responses of beings that people were seeing. Okay, so my question now I'm posing to you, okay, are these 10s of 1000s of different physical beings that appear almost all of the cases for less than a minute? Okay? People out there having a beer with one of these beans for three hours? You know, shoot the greens. You know, it's like you see them. They last less than a minute. Boom, they're gone. Okay? Now, are these beings 10s of 1000s of different beings, coming from 10s of 1000s of different planets, or is this something a little bit more complicated? Now, Jacques valet said that these were multi dimensional experiences. Sure. Okay. Alan Heineck said the same thing before he died. Doctor John Mack, yeah, okay, a professor of psychiatry from Harvard University, in his book passport to the cosmos, he said, these are multi dimensional experiences that these people are having. They're being brought to other dimensions. You're seeing the versatile of different types of beings, sure, again, for less than a minute. Okay, so if these three brilliant minds in the field of ufology saying that these experiences are multi dimensional, that they involve, quote, unquote, what Jack Vale said, a manipulation of space time, okay, the conclusion that we reached in our book, beyond UFOs, was that the UFO phenomenon is a multi dimensional experience involving a manipulation of space time, sure. Now let me ask you another question. Near Death. Experiences, is there a manipulation of space time, obviously, without a body. Experiences, is there a manipulation of space time? With astral travel experiences? Is there a manipulation of space time? If Are you seeing your aunt, Matilda, one week after she died, she's in your living room. Is that a manipulation of space time? Okay? Well, Ayahuasca, okay, you

And then all of a sudden, all around him were these short grain aliens, okay, a typical short gray aliens. And they were laughing with him. They were smiling. He was interacting with them. He was having a good ass time with these little gray beings out of body, okay? Then all of a sudden, he goes back into his body, and then he hears noise in his room, and he thought that a burglar, someone had entered his room. So he starts looking around, and it was these five gray aliens, okay, he described this three feet tall, you know, like the typical race. And then he freaks out. Okay, he freaks out. He's got petrified. He was shivering, he couldn't even talk, he couldn't even move. And then the one the beans, came up to him and got close to him, and he became more settled. And then they communicated with him telepathically to relax, you know that they're not going to do him any harm. And then all of a sudden, they put into his mind tons of love. And the book is somewhat based on a group of people like that that are using a medical induced near death experience, to go to that non physical world and gain the other thing they get sometimes is kind of superpowers, powers that allow them, they give them pre capabilities or Remote viewing capabilities, and a few other ones. And so the idea of the book is that some people learn how to do this, and maybe through who listen. So should I go back historically now maybe, oh,

Maybe it wasn't a drug, but they would come back, and they formed the foundation of all our science or government or our republic mathematics. They all came out of their trips to elusive and one of the premises of the novel is that Jesus, a lot of people confuse this, that the death on the cross is not his, his his enlightenment experience or his near death experience. It's when he went into the desert after being baptized for 40 days, yeah, and he came out enlightened, and then he talked about all these revolutionary ways that you two are the Son of God, and these high philosophical concept concepts that got him into trouble and got him killed. So most people kind of confuse those two things. So the big event was the the event in the desert where he got became enlightened, and his teachers teachings were based on that. Then, of course, later on. You know, it's very hard to base to scale experience, but belief is easy to scale. Does that make sense to you?

And you know, all our politics, all that stuff, is based on beliefs, yeah, not so much on on experiences, yeah. Well,

I'm pretty certain UFOs exist, you know, like I'm positive that, at the very least, an unidentified flying object exists to science, something that they cannot explain in the air. So I don't believe UFOs exist. UFOs exist, you know, and very much the same thing, like you're saying, that idea of amplifying belief and taking it to a larger scale, scaling belief to the masses is much easier to do as a means of control than, than an esoteric teaching that allows for individuality, or, you

Most of what we do throughout the day is rote hypnosis, like if, if you are, if you are used to filling out the same form all day, every day at work, you may be looking at some new data, but your fingers in your brain are going through the rote hypnosis of where that tab belongs. You know, as you're typing things like that, no, no different than driving to work five days a week, and three of those days, you go, Oh, dang, I'm I'm at my exit already. You know, our brain would much rather live in that altered state where it doesn't have to make a decision, aside from breathe, be upright, digest food, you know, that kind of stuff. So so the idea that a near death experiences are not extraordinarily uncommon

It is still to this day what, what I ascribe to be God when I feel it, um, but, but nobody else in that church saw that. Nobody like I literally live right down the road from a guy that was serving at the altar with me, and he was like, Yeah, I didn't see anything like that. I didn't feel anything like that. I was awake. I wasn't asleep, I wasn't coming out of surgery. I wasn't I don't know maybe I was being affected by something electronically, but I was in a church in 1992 so it's not like we had the internet or a lot of things like that, you know, and it, it really is the fact that, once again, yeah, those those experiences are very, very individual, and they're very life changing when they happen.
